Zach Sakas, Esq. of Greenberg Traurig, outside counsel for the Superstition Vistas Community Facilities District No. 1 presented to the Board that Resolution No. SVCFD1 2025-011 authorizes general obligation bonds to be repaid with secondary property taxes. The total bond amount is not to exceed \$7,500,000.00 and will be paid over a period of 25 years. The project that the bonds will pay for are Ray Avenue street improvements. Mr. Sakas explained the feasibility report and public hearing process.
