Background

- A GLO easement is a roadway and utility easement created by the initial transfer of land titles from the Federal government to an individual through the General Land Office (GLO) through the Bureau of Land Management (BLM), pursuant to the provisions of an Act of Congress approved June 1, 1938.
- Federal Patent Easements (FPEs) are either 5 or 2 ½ acre parcels with a reservation of right-of-way of 33' in width along the boundaries of said land on private property.
- The reservation of right-of-way along the boundaries of the land ensured that no individual parcel would be land locked, or without legal access to the land.



Process (cont'd)

- Utility and Emergency Responder Notification
 - An exhibit of the requested easement is sent to all public utility providers and emergency responders requesting a response for objection or no objection for roadway easement extinguishment only. If no response is received within two weeks then another request is sent.
