ARTICLE 8-8: REQUIREMENTS
FOR COMMUNITY AND
CIVIC EVENTS



POTENTIAL CHANGES TO CITY CODE

- 1. Repeal and/or replace section 8-8 (Community & Civic Events)
- 2. Update section 8-10 (Mobile & Temporary Food & Beverage Vendors) to reflect current state laws
- 3. Create a Special Event section within Parks and Recreation
 Chapter 15 that addresses the city-wide special event
 permitting regulations
- 4. Possible other references to special events within the city code



NEXT STEPS

- 1. Receive Direction to Staff tonight
- 2. Bring back research and draft code changes to a future work session for council review/consideration
- 3. Future public hearing to adopt new/revised ordinances/code changes



RECOMMENDED DIRECTION TO STAFF
