Presentation, discussion, public hearing, and recommendation to the City Council of case P-23-128-ART, a proposal by 29th Street Capital for a public art mural along the eastern wall of the new multifamily development known as The Residences at Apache Trail, located on the southwest corner of Broadway Avenue and Tomahawk Road. The Public Art Commission’s recommendation is tentatively scheduled to be presented to the City Council at their work session on April 1, 2024.

Artist Paige Reesor provided information on her background as an artist and gave a presentation on the murals with several options of digital mock-ups for the commission to view. She asked for questions from the commission.

The commission stated they would like to see the local mountains included in the mural; Superstitions, Four Peaks, Goldfields, sunsets, quail, roadrunners, perhaps work in Canyon Lake, Apache Lake. The shades discussed were colorful desert and blue shades.

Artist Reesor stated she can revise the mock-ups in a short amount of time, 1-2 weeks.

Landscape Architect Tim Dougherty with 29th St. Capital stated the mural will be on the eastern wall of the project, 350' in length by 6' in height, and will be located away from signage.

The commission decided to continue the meeting in order to view the revised mock-ups from the artist before they make their recommendation to city council.
