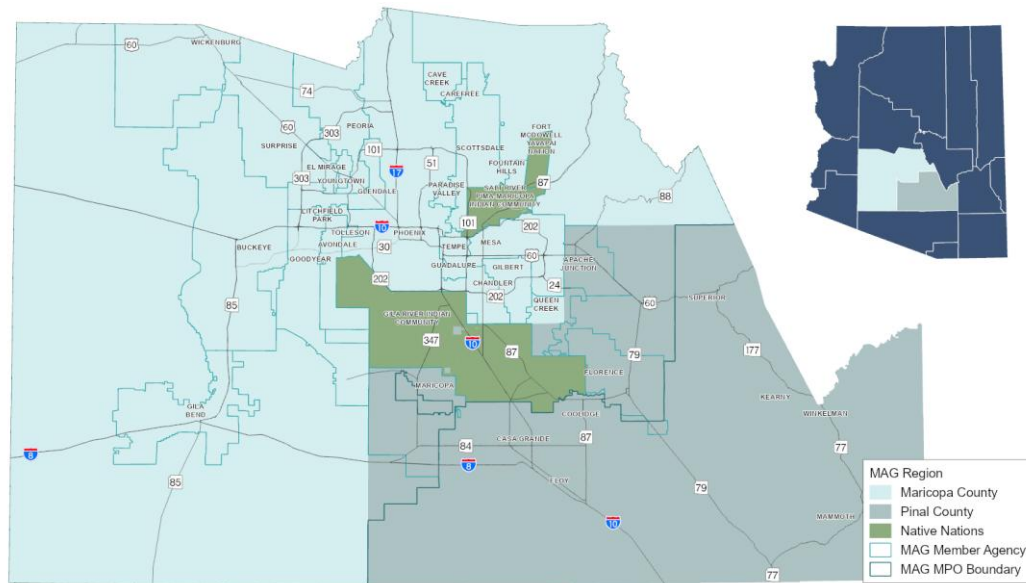

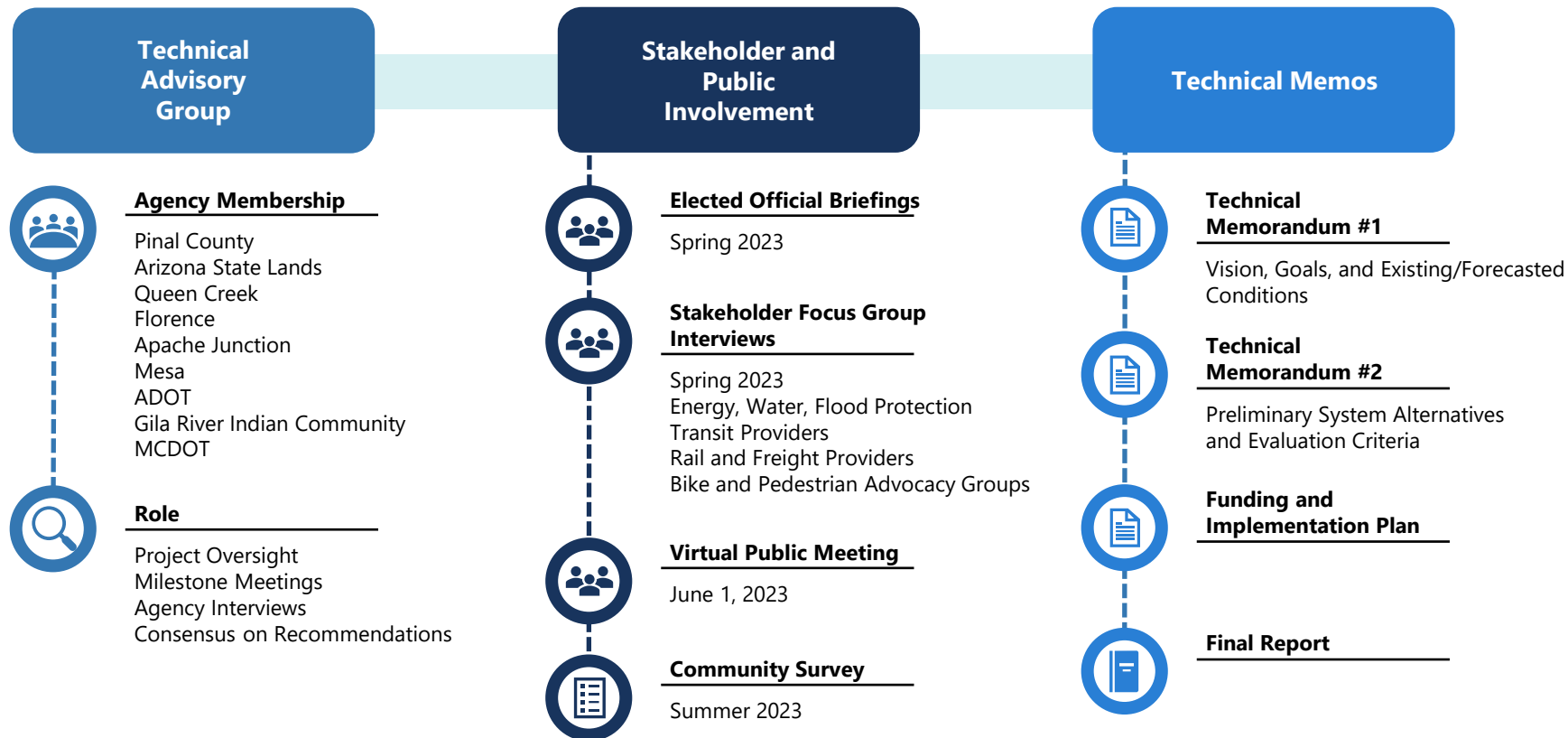

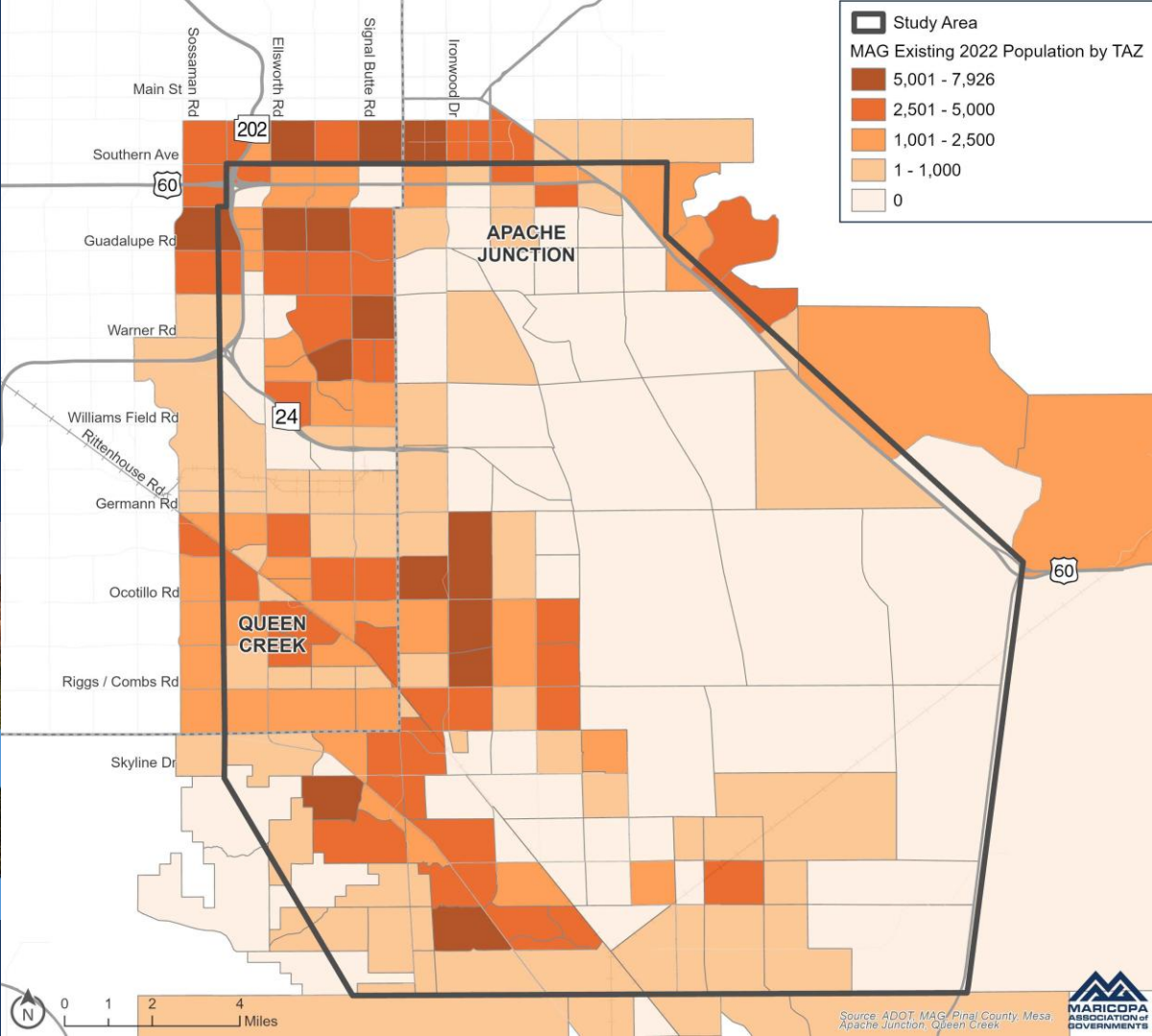

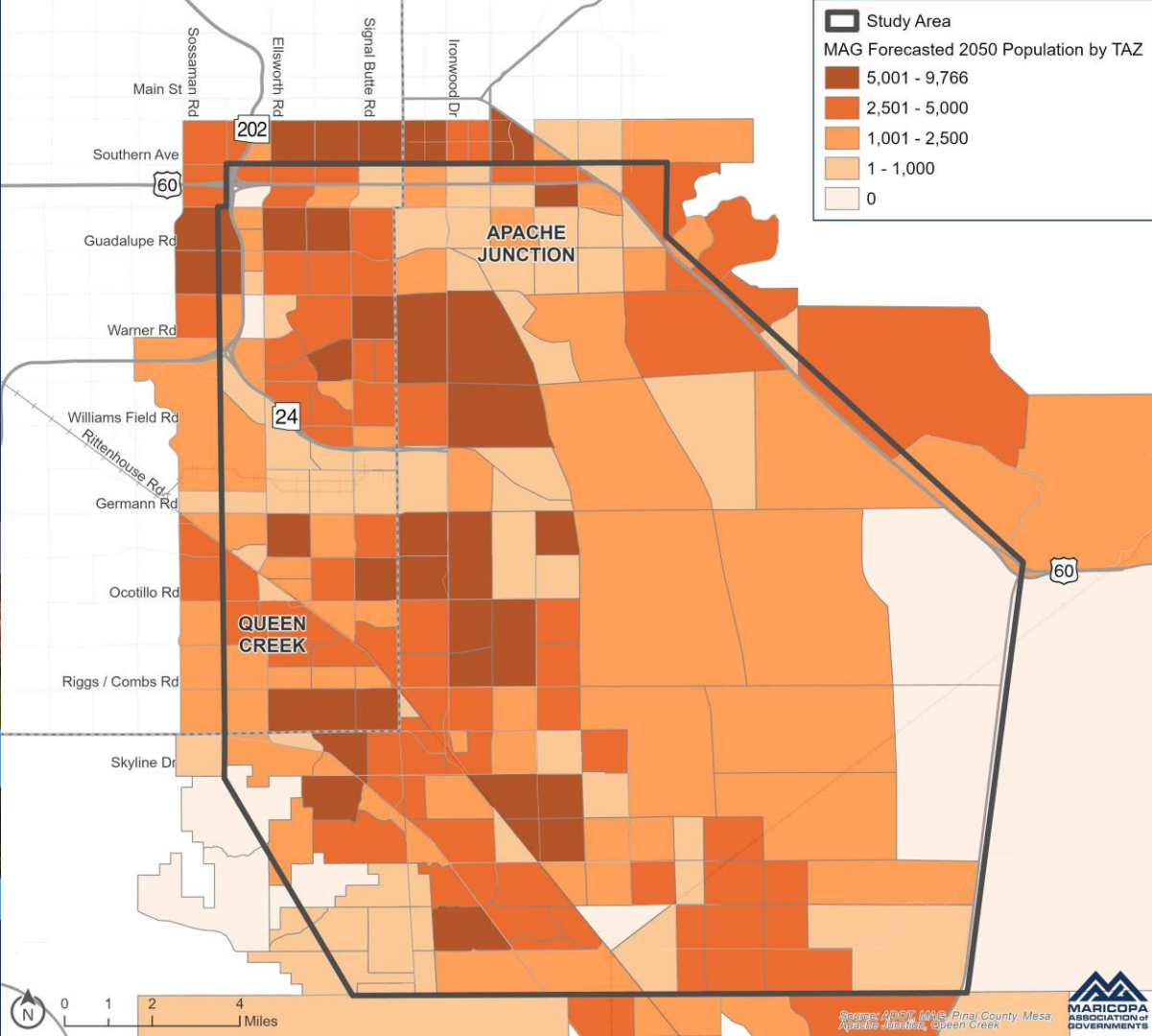

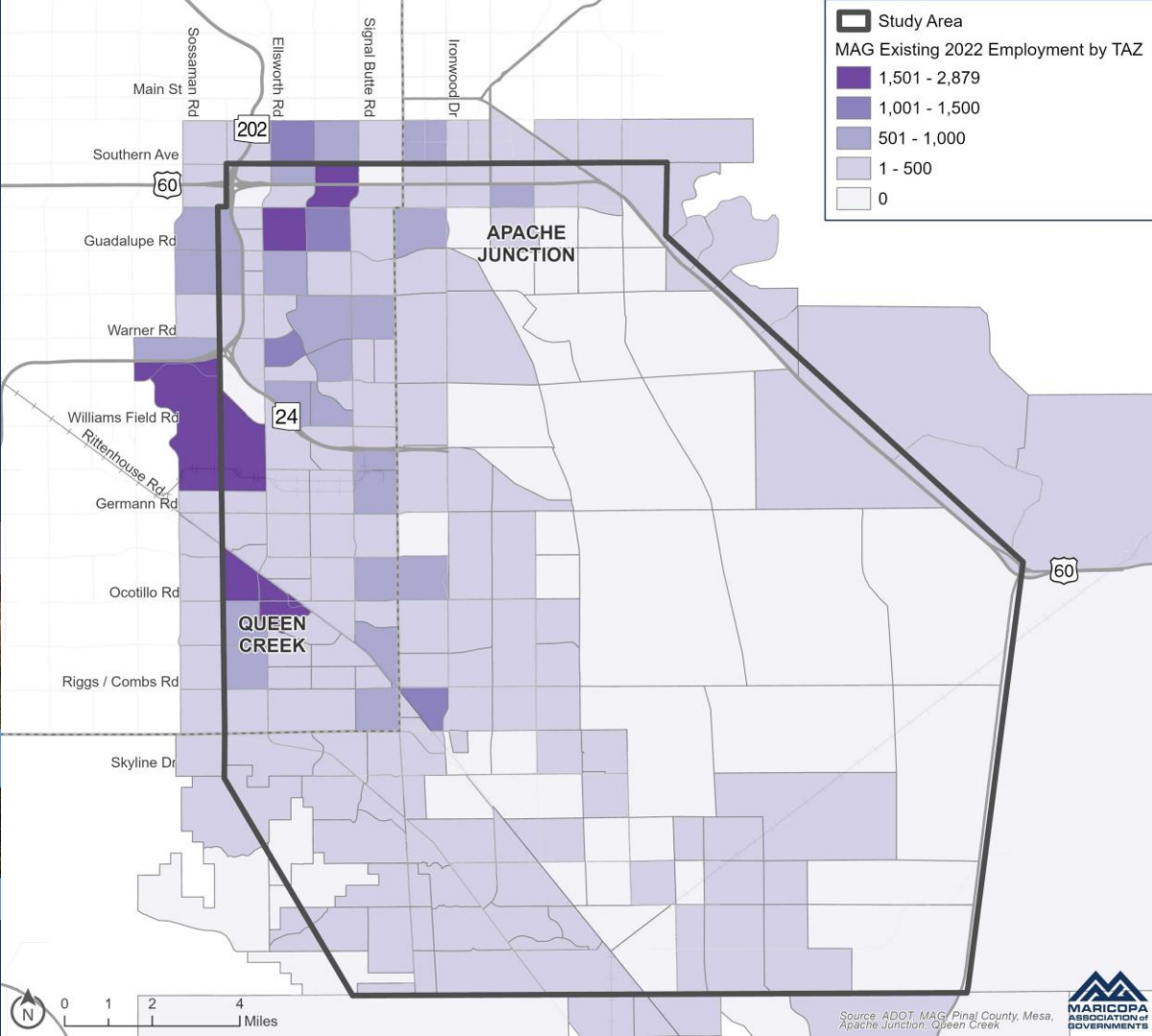
2030 Population Growth



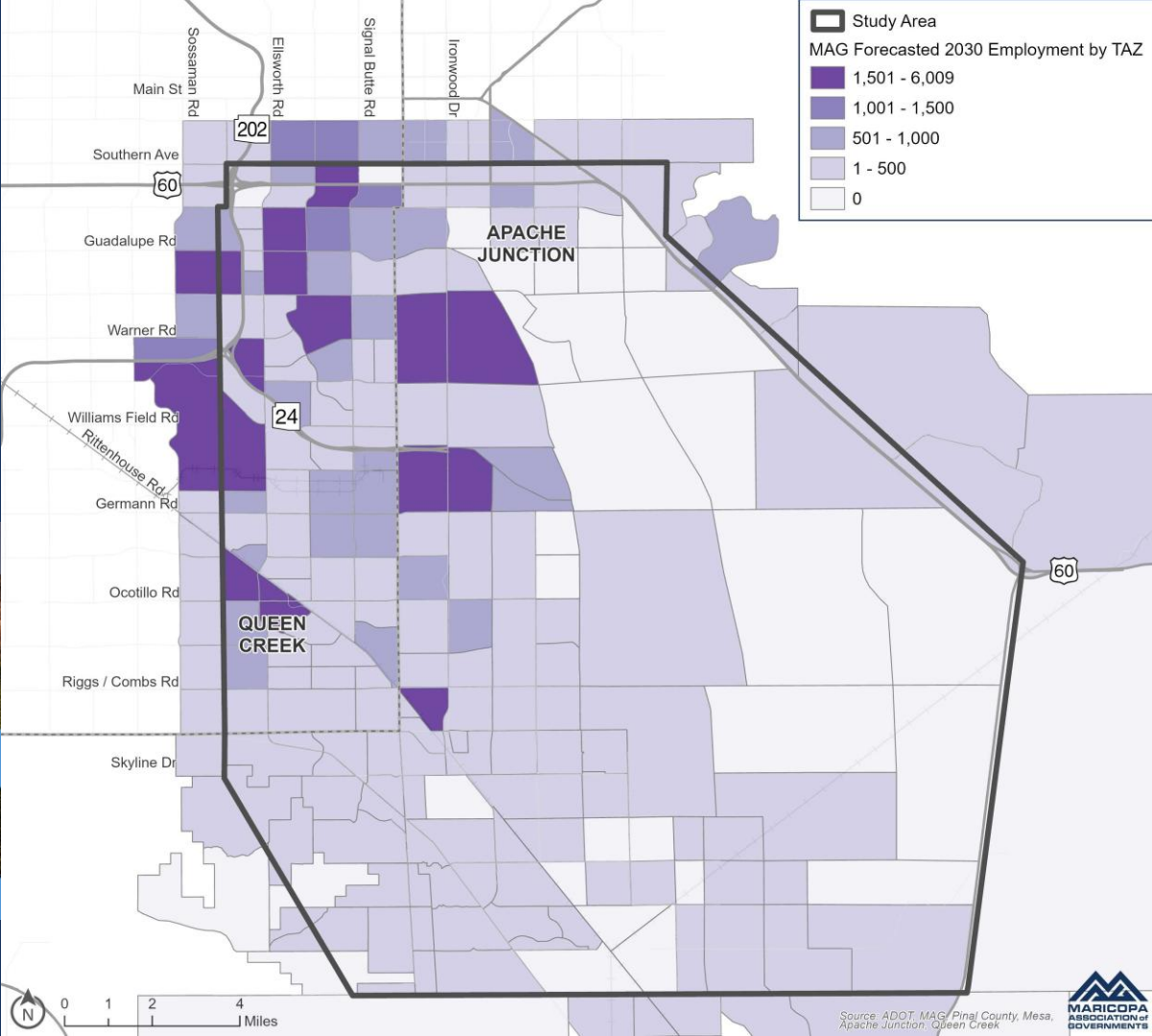
2050 Population Growth



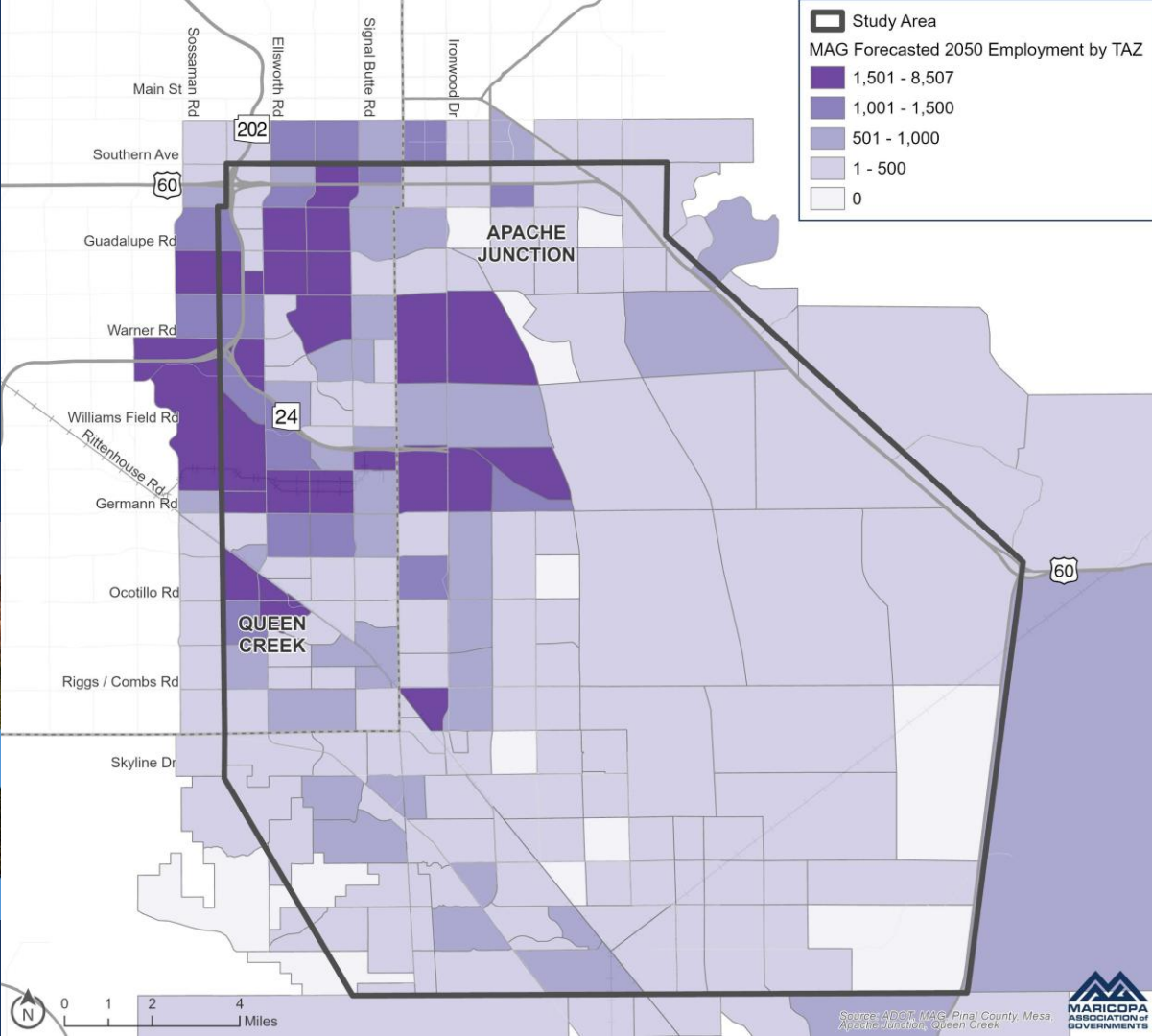
Existing Employment



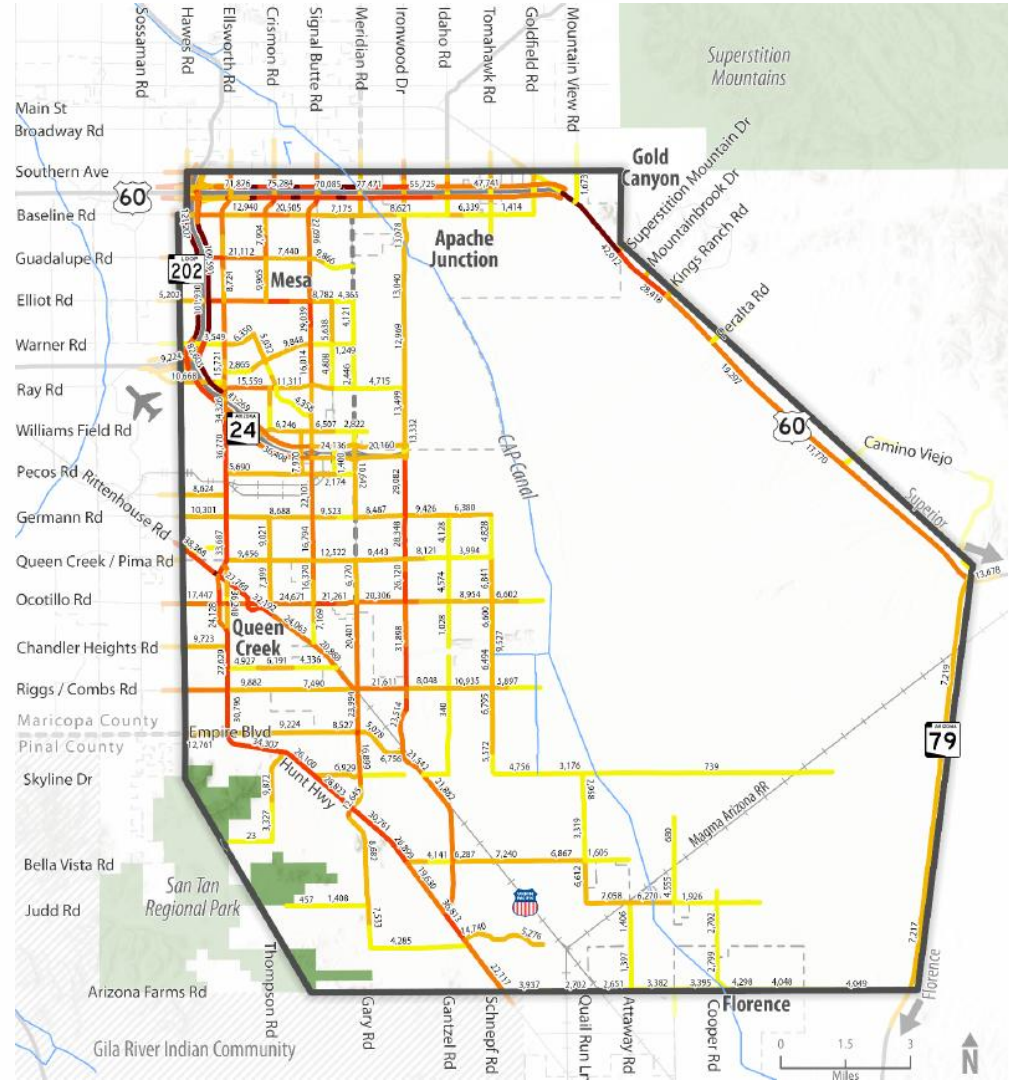
2030 Employment Growth



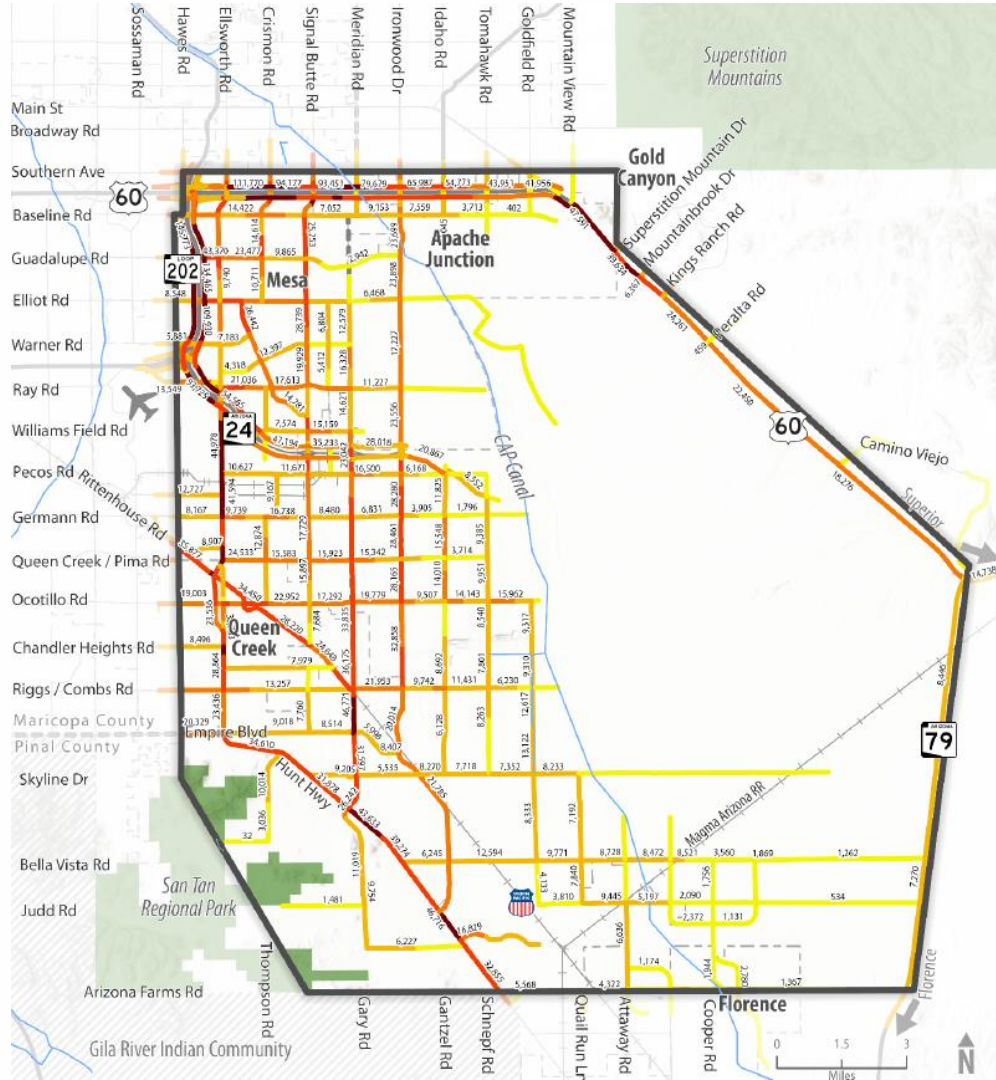

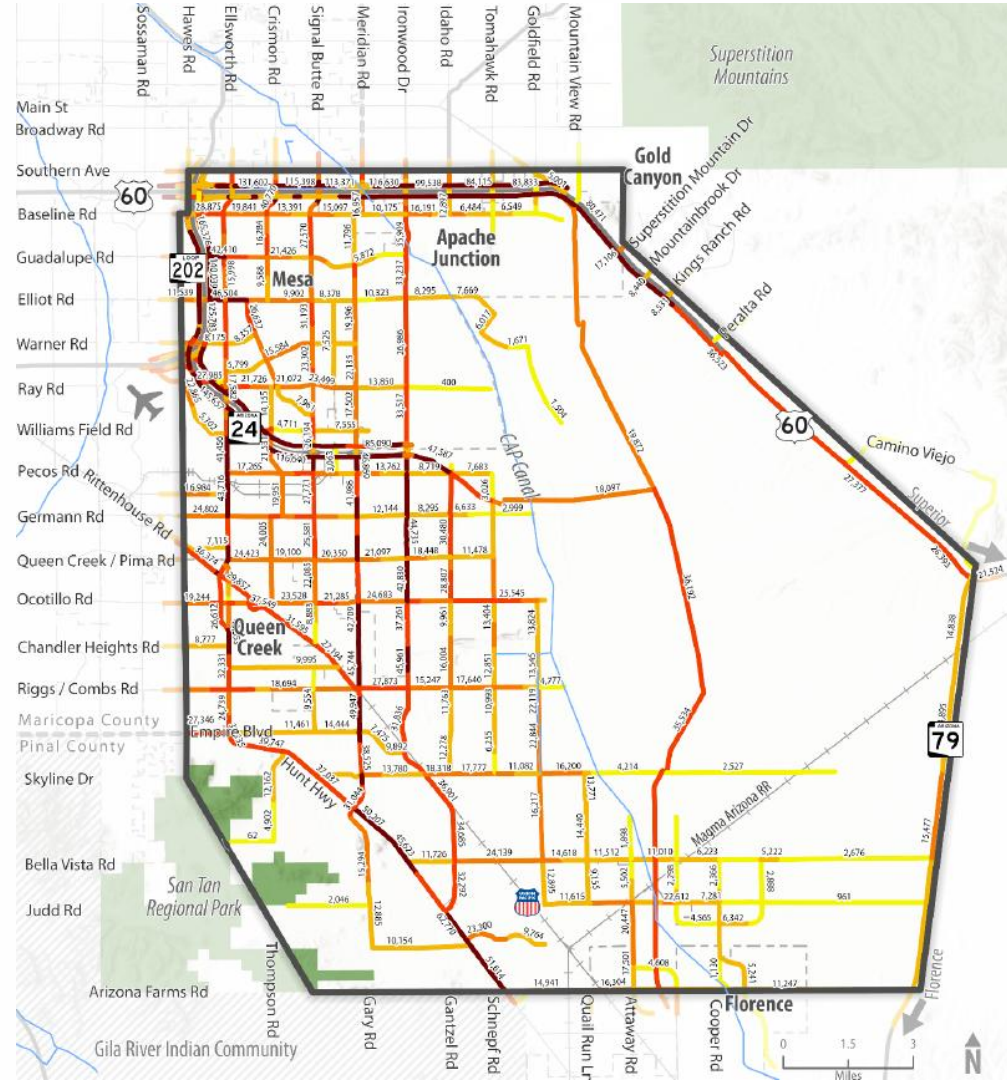
Existing Traffic Volumes



2030 Traffic Volumes

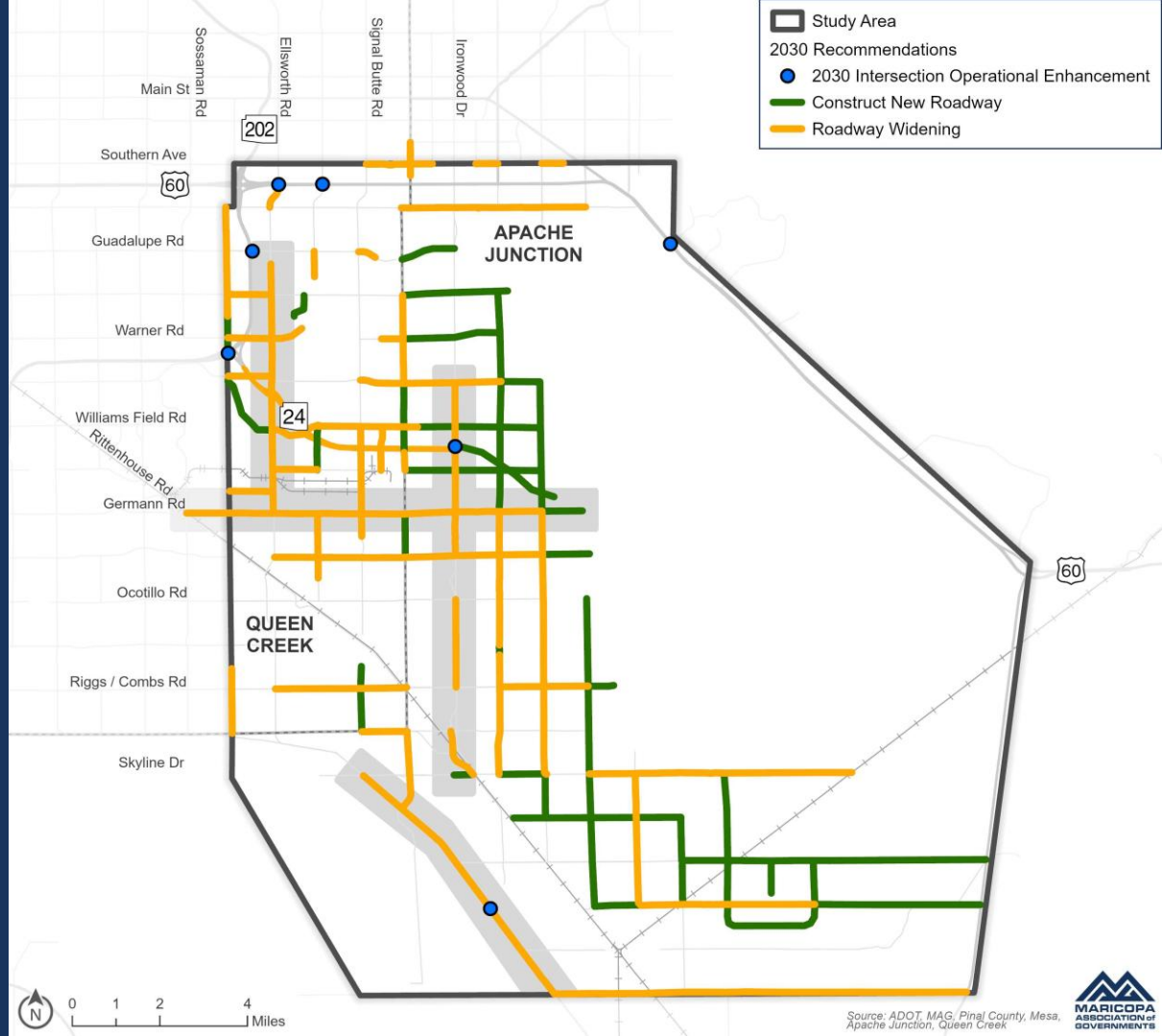

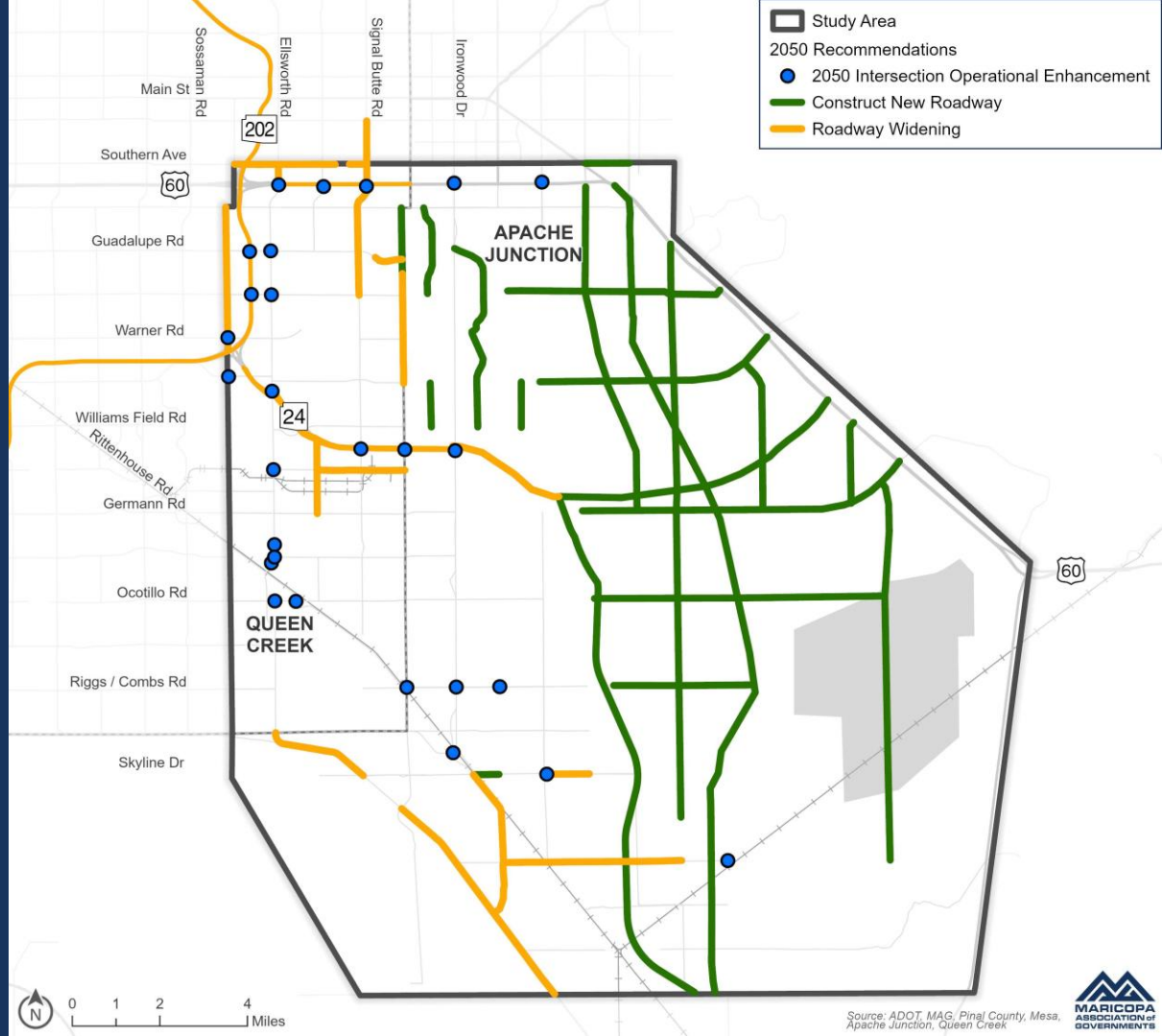

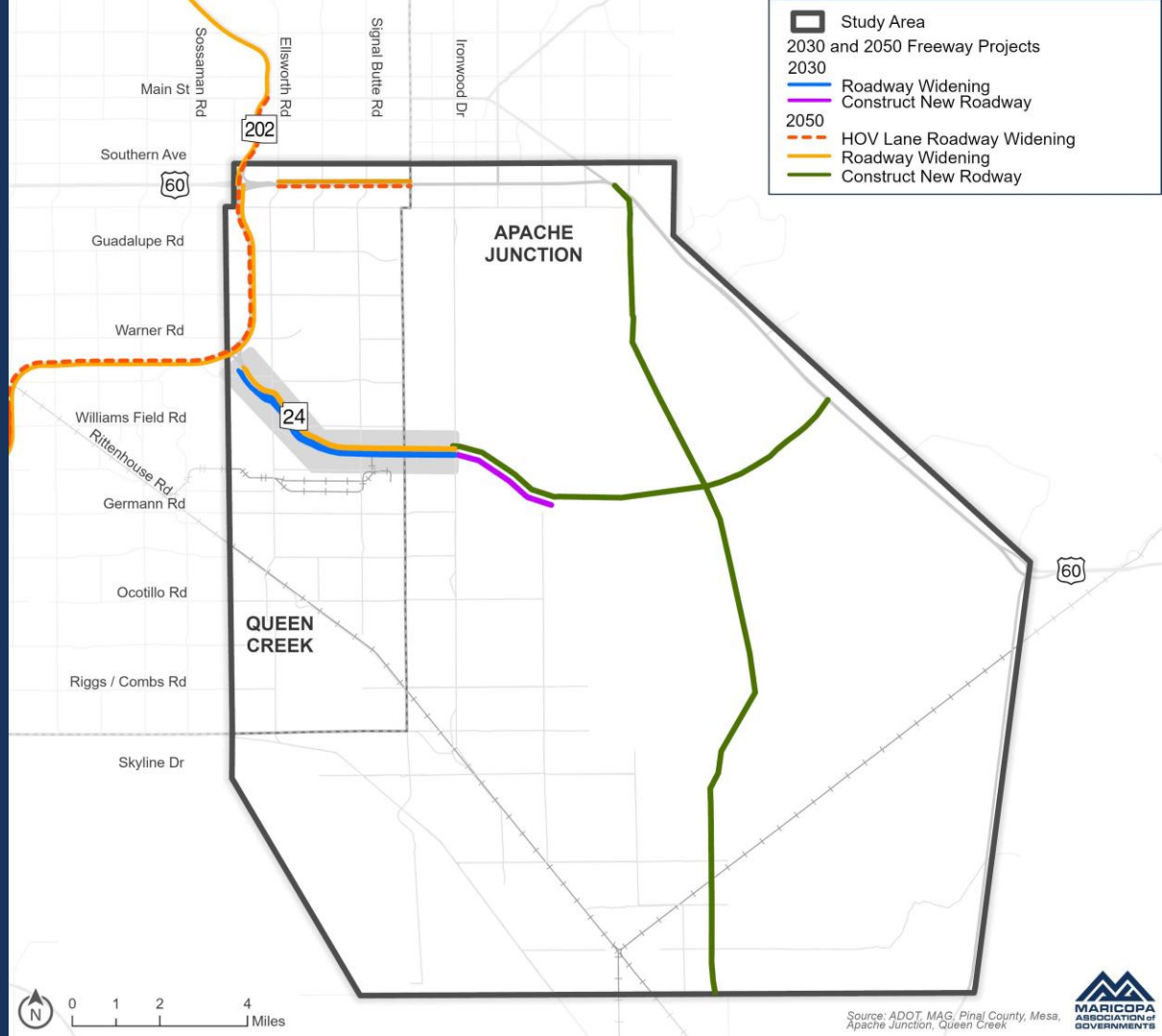

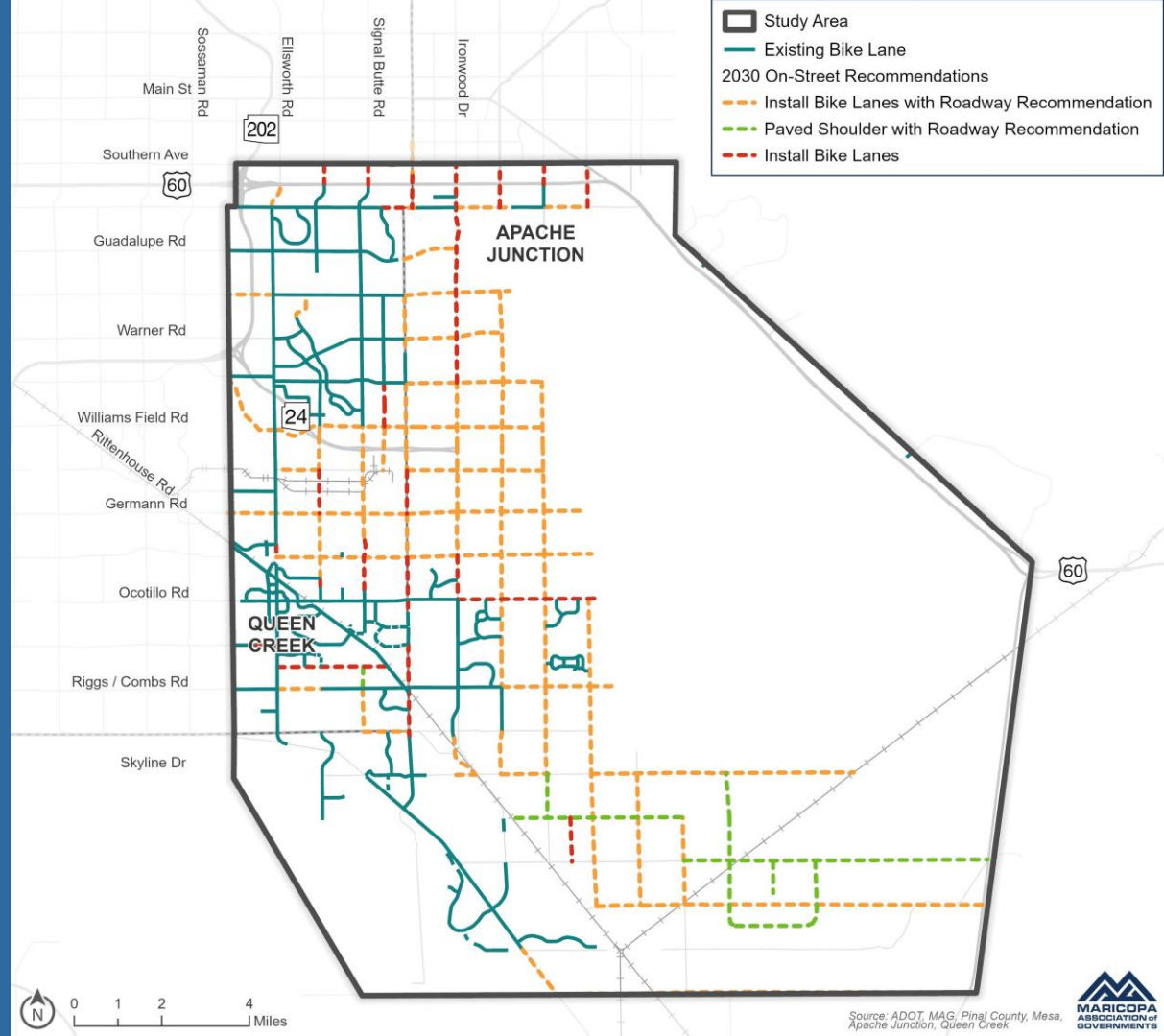

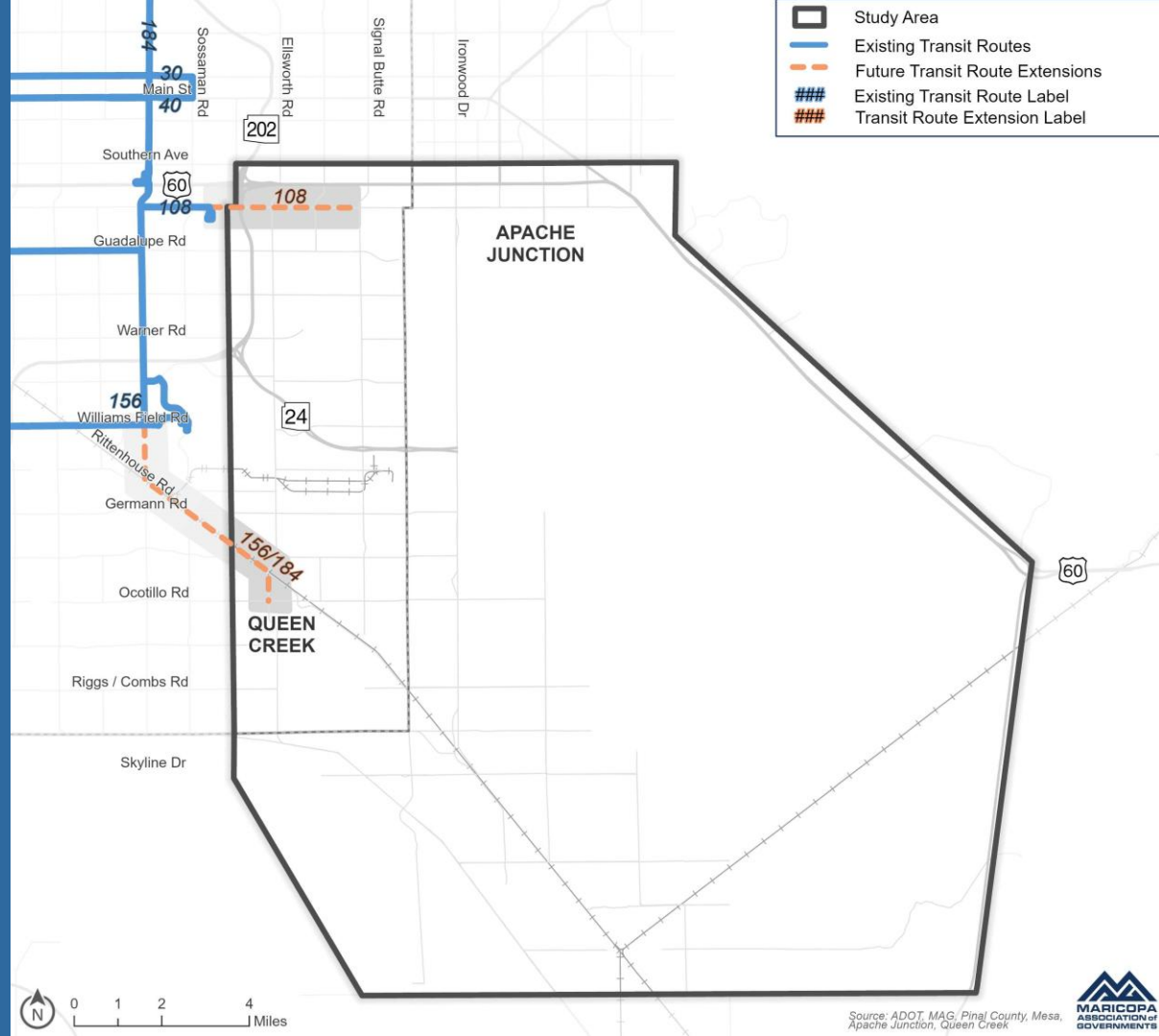
