Zach Sakas, Esq. of Greenberg Traurig, outside counsel for the Superstition Vistas Community Facilities District No. 1, presented agenda items 2, 3 and 4 to the Board regarding approval of the annual SVCFD No. 1 budget. Mr. Sakas explained that the CFD approval process is a two-step process. The first step is the consideration of the tentative budget for the district. He stated the district has four sources of revenue;

- operations and maintenance property taxes used to pay for district operations, maintenance, and administration.
- general obligations bond debt service property taxes; special assessment installment payments.
- cash contributions from the developer.

Item 2 approves Resolution No. SVCFD1 2026-006, the consideration of the proposed budget. Item 3 is conducting a public hearing on the tentative or proposed budget, and item 4, Resolution No. SVCFD1 2026-007 is the adoption of the final budget for the CFD for the upcoming fiscal year. Mr. Sakas further explained that the tax levy increased following the amendment of the CFD agreement establishing a target tax rate of \$5.00 and would remain at a combined levy of \$5.30 for the fiscal year.

Chair Wilson opened the public hearing. Receiving no comments, he closed the public hearing.
