Superstition Blvd., Apache Junction, Arizona, or for call-in at 480-982-8002.

SECTION III

Money from any fund may be used for any of the appropriations, except money specifically restricted by state law or by city ordinance or by city resolutions. The transfer of any sum within any specific appropriation may be made upon the approval of the city manager.
