ORDINANCE NO. 1551

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF APACHE JUNCTION, ARIZONA, AMENDING APACHE JUNCTION CITY CODE, VOLUME I, CHAPTER 4: FEES, ARTICLE 4-7: PUBLIC SAFETY FEE SCHEDULE; REPEALING ANY CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes Titles 9 and 38, cities and towns are authorized to charge for various public safety services; and

WHEREAS, the mayor and city council have over time amended the public safety fee schedule (Ordinance No. 1263 - April 4, 2006, Ordinance No. 1333 - January 20, 2009 and Ordinance No. 1435 - January 17, 2017); and

WHEREAS, police staff recommends certain fee increases and new fees based on comparisons with other agencies and changes in public records request laws; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to council direction to staff and A.R.S. § 9-499.15, staff provided a 60-day notice of intent to amend the fee schedule and posted it on the city's website; and

WHEREAS, on August 6, 2024, a public hearing was held on the amendments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF APACHE JUNCTION, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I IN GENERAL

The <u>Apache Junction City Code</u>, Volume I, Chapter 4: <u>Fees</u>, Article 4-7: <u>Public Safety Fee Schedule</u>, is hereby amended in its entirety, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 4 PUBLIC SAFETY FEE SCHEDULE

- A. Department, accident reports and computer aided dispatch ("CAD") requests:
 - 1.Commercial: \$5.00 for pages 1 through 20, \$0.25 for each page thereafter;
 - 2.Non-commercial: \$0.25 per page; and
 - B. Certified copies of department and accident reports: \$10.00 for pages 1 through 20, 50¢ for each page thereafter.

1. Documents/Reports

Reports (pgs. 1-20) \$5.00/ each page \$10.00 Certified copy thereafter

Miscellaneous \$5.00 \$10.00 Certified copy documents

2. Victims of crime: no charge.

SECTION II REPEALING ANY CONFLICTING PROVISIONS

All other ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance or in conflict with any part of the code adopted herein by reference are also hereby repealed.

SECTION III PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY

If any section, subsection, sentence, phrase, clause or portion of this ordinance, or any part of the code adopted herein by reference is for any reason held to be invalid, pre-empted or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decisions shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.
