City staff respectfully requests city council consideration of award of contract to Viasun Corporation for project PWC2019-13D for the installation of curbing for the Apache Trail medians between Ironwood Drive and Ocotillo Drive for a not to exceed amount including 10% contingency for unforeseens of \$380,072.82.

This work was discussed with council at the July 18, 2023 City Council regular session under Public Works' "Fiscal Year 2024 CIP & Street Maintenance Plan." The work involves the construction of cement concrete curbs around the medians to facilitate roadway drainage and protect landscape improvements planned for these median areas. The work would last for about two to three weeks planned for in the October – November 2023 timeframe. Work would occur during the daytime hours only with limited impacts to vehicular traffic lanes and no impacts expected to adjacent business entrances.
