

RESOLUTION NO. 19-19

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF APACHE JUNCTION, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF APACHE JUNCTION TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH MARICOPA COUNTY FOR GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION SYSTEMS DATA SHARING.

WHEREAS, the City of Apache Junction ("City") and Maricopa County ("County") (collectively the "Parties") desire to enter into an intergovernmental agreement ("IGA") allowing them to cooperatively exchange geographic information systems ("GIS") data; and

WHEREAS, GIS data assists City and other public entities with infrastructure development and land management; and

WHEREAS, the Parties each seek to enhance the public services they provide by increasing the GIS data available to them; and

WHEREAS, County has assisted in the design and implementation of a method of sharing GIS data maintained by both County and other public entities; and

WHEREAS, the Parties have crafted a written agreement which sets forth the conditions for such arrangement; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to A.R.S. § 11-952(A), public entities may enter into intergovernmental agreements for joint or cooperative action.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF APACHE JUNCTION, ARIZONA AS FOLLOWS:

- 1) The mayor and city council approve the form of the intergovernmental agreement as set forth in Attachment A; and the mayor is hereby authorized to sign the agreement on behalf of the City.
- 2) The city manager or his designee is authorized and directed to take all steps necessary to carry out the purpose and

intent of this resolution and to fulfill all the duties
required under the agreement.
