Subject: Project # SST23-17 Award

City staff respectfully requests city council consideration of award of contract to MR Tanner Construction for project SST23-17 for the retrofit of Broadway Avenue sidewalk ramps for a not to exceed amount including 10% contingency for unforeseens of \$141,671.90. Project is budgeted with use of Street Sales Tax monies.

This work was discussed with council at the July 18, 2023 City Council regular session under Public Works' "Fiscal Year 2024 CIP & Street Maintenance Plan." The work involves the retrofit of sidewalk ramps along Broadway to bring them up to current Americans with Disability Act ("ADA") standards. By law, ADA improvements need to be completed when a street is improved which Broadway is looked to be repaved within the next couple years. The segment of Broadway Ave. to be covered by this project is from Meridian Drive to Idaho Road. The work would last for about two to three weeks during the October 2023 – January 2024 timeframe. Work would occur during the daytime hours with lane and sidewalk closures planned only for those areas active with construction.
