Subject: Project # SST23-27 Award

City staff respectfully requests city council consideration of award of contract to Sunland Asphalt & Construction for project SST23-27 for the application of pavement preservation fog seal to select city streets for a not to exceed amount including 10% contingency for unforeseens of \$289,935.37. Project is budgeted for use of Street Sales Tax monies.

This work was discussed with council at the July 18, 2023 City Council regular session under Public Works' "Fiscal Year 2024 CIP & Street Maintenance Plan." The work involves the fog sealing of various city streets including portions of Lost Dutchman Blvd., Southern Ave. and Baseline Avenue. The work would last for about a week during the March – May 2024 timeframe. Work would occur during the daytime hours only with limited impacts to vehicular traffic lanes and residential entrances.
