A group including City Management, Finance, Legal and the Police Department met multiple times to go over the Request for Proposal (RFP) prior to its release. Scoring the accepted proposals occurred over 3 days and was done individually by the scorers based on criteria set forth in the RFP.

## GOHS Grants

- Annual Governors Office Of Highway Safety Grants
  - How we are able to work enforcement and accidents within the City of Apache Junction and then work specific enforcement areas
  - \$84,801 total in grants over 4 areas

- Grant Areas- 4
  - Police Traffic Services (Speeding, Aggressive Driving)
    - \$59,801- overtime \$38, 801 OT and \$21,000 equipment
  - Impaired Driving Enforcement (DUI)
    - \$15,000 overtime
  - Occupant Protection (Seatbelt, Distracted Driving, Child Seat)
    - \$5000 overtime
  - Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety ( Jaywalking)
    - \$5000 overtime
