2. <u>25-500</u> Conduct a public hearing on the feasibility report for a proposed project to be

financed by the issuance of the Superstition Vistas Community Facilities

District No. 1 Assessment Area No. 6 Special Assessment Bonds.

Chair Wilson opened the public hearing, receiving no comments, Chair Wilson closed the public hearing.

Zach Sakas, Esq. of Greenberg Traurig, outside counsel for the Superstition Vistas Community Facilities District No. 1 presented to the Board the special assessment bonds for Assessment

Area 6 in D.R. Horton's Radiance development. He explained this was funding 191 lots on Officer Facio Drive (formerly Davis Drive) with the assessment being \$5,000.00 each.
