Subject: Project # HFS24-01 Award of Contract

City staff respectfully requests city council consideration of award of contract to Viasun Corporation for project HFS24-01 for pedestrian improvements to the sidewalks and traffic signal pedestrian facilities at Southern Avenue and Ironwood Drive for a not to exceed amount including 10% contingency for unforeseens of \$294,573.00.

Public Works' "Fiscal Year 2024 CIP & Street Maintenance Plan" includes this project that was discussed with council at the July 18, 2023 City Council regular session. Work involves the reconstruction of sidewalks, sidewalk ramps and traffic signal pedestrian facilities ("ped buttons") at the intersection. This project will bring the facilities up to ADA standards which was identified and prioritized as a high-volume pedestrian intersection. The work would last for about two to three weeks planned for in the April – June 2024 timeframe. Work would occur during the daytime hours only with periodic impacts to vehicular traffic lanes and no impacts to adjacent business or school entrances.
