Development Services has no zoning-related objections to a restaurant with a bar re-occupying the former La Casita Restaurant building at 495 W. Apache Trail. The property is zoned B-1, which allows restaurants and bars outright.

However, there is some remodeling work which has apparently started at the property which requires the submittal of a building permit, along with plans drawn by an Arizona registrant. The scope of work includes plumbing, making the bathrooms ADA compliant, electrical work, tying into the sewer system and other work. The proprietors were informed of this requirement several weeks ago, they have acknowledged that they need a permit and plan to hire an architect to get the work done.

In the meantime, a positive recommendation for the liquor license is not an issue. And staff looks forward to working with the property owners through the permits and inspections process.
