D. CONSENT AGENDA

The council may, at this time, take single action on any or all items listed as consent agenda items. These may include, but are not limited to, acceptance of agenda, acceptance of minutes, appointments, acceptance of resignations and adoption of certain resolutions and other items which do not require a public hearing. The consent agenda is a timesaving device of which the mayor and city council is to receive documentation on these items from the city manager for their review prior to the meeting. Any member of the council may remove any item from the consent agenda for discussion and cause a separate vote on the matter later in the agenda.

[16-97](#) Consideration of approval to enter into contract with Sunland Asphalt for work through The Cooperative Purchasing Network cooperative contract #R5225 for \$825,236.04 with a ten percent contingency of \$82,523.60 for a total not to exceed amount of \$907,759.64. The work would span two fiscal years contingent on funding available.

[16-98](#) Consideration of proposed Resolution No. 16-07, recommending the city's Fiscal Year 2016 Local Transportation Assistance Fund II allocation be directed to the Apache Junction Active Adult Center (dba East Valley Adult Resources) for support of transportation services and authorizing the mayor to sign a pass-through agreement.
5. [16-99](#) Consideration of proposed Resolution No. 16-08, approving the amendments to the International City Manager Association (ICMA) 401(A) retirement plan and authorizing renewal of the governmental profit-sharing plan and trust adoption agreement.

F. ANNOUNCEMENT OF CURRENT EVENTS

The mayor or any member of council may at this time present a brief summary of current events. However, no discussion shall take place on such items except for clarifying comments related to substance, time and location.

G. CITY MANAGER'S REPORT

The city manager, members of city staff or those individuals designated by the manager may present information pertinent to items under consideration or information related to the operation of the city. There shall however be no discussion at this time except for clarification inquiries.

H. PUBLIC HEARINGS

Public hearings required by applicable law shall be conducted by the council and any person shall be given the opportunity to speak. All remarks shall be addressed to the council as a whole and not to any member thereof. Such remarks shall be limited to five (5) minutes unless additional time is granted by the mayor. This time limitation shall not apply to applicants and their agents appearing before the council.

[16-108](#) Consideration of application for a special event liquor license for the Boys and Girls Club of the East Valley - Apache Junction Branch for April 9, 2016 for their Yesteryear fundraising event. The next step in the process is for the council to hold a public hearing on the application and make a recommendation for approval or denial to be forwarded to the Arizona Department of Liquor Licenses and Control.
9. [16-105](#) Public hearing, presentation, discussion and consideration of proposed Ordinance No. 1426, case PZ-2-15, a city-initiated corrective rezoning from Recreational Vehicle Park (RVP) to Recreational Vehicle Park by Planned Development (RVP/PD) of the Pueblo RV Resort, an RV subdivision totaling approximately 20 acres. The adoption of the city's new zoning maps inadvertently zoned this subdivision incorrectly. The Pueblo is located at
201 E. Southern Avenue, at the southeast corner of S. Idaho Road and E. Southern Avenue.

10. [16-112](#) Public hearing, presentation, discussion and consideration of proposed Ordinance No. 1427, case PZ-1-16, a city-initiated corrective rezoning for a +/- 1.25 acre vacant portion of a +/- 8 acre parcel (101-16-013C) from Recreational Vehicle Park (RVP) to General Commercial (B-1). The adoption of the city's new zoning maps inadvertently zoned this portion incorrectly. This corrective rezoning seeks to re-assign this portion a B-1 zoning district located at 1586 W. Broadway Avenue, at the northeast corner of S. Ironwood Drive and W. Broadway Avenue for future commercial development opportunities.

I. OLD BUSINESS

M. CALL TO PUBLIC

At this time the public has the privilege to address the council with requests, communications, comments or suggestions relating to city business that are not listed on the agenda. All speakers must have already submitted a written "Request to Speak" form to the city clerk no later than the conclusion of the city manager's report portion of the agenda. If there is a group speaking on the same item, they should select a spokesperson. All such remarks shall be addressed to the council as a whole and not to any member thereof. The mayor is authorized to ask a speaker to stop speaking and leave the podium or to adjourn the meeting if anyone becomes disorderly, uncivil, makes personal attacks or continues to speak about items that are not within the jurisdiction of the city after being warned such issues are beyond the jurisdiction of the city to act. The council may not answer questions of the speaker, discuss the matter with one another, but may, at the conclusion: 1) respond to criticism by a speaker; 2) ask the city manager to review a matter; 3) ask the city manager to place the matter on a future agenda. Each speaker must approach the podium, speak into the microphone, provide their name and address. There is a three (3) minute time limit per speaker.
