D. CONSENT AGENDA

H. PUBLIC HEARINGS

Public hearings required by applicable law shall be conducted by the council and any person shall be given the opportunity to speak. All remarks shall be addressed to the council as a whole and not to any member thereof. Such remarks shall be limited to five (5) minutes unless additional time is granted by the mayor. This time limitation shall not apply to applicants and their agents appearing before the council.

K. COUNCIL DIRECTION TO STAFF

11. 19-528 Presentation, discussion and direction to staff regarding miscellaneous amendments to Volume I, Chapter 7 Administrative Code including park model additions in RV subdivisions, age of newly set manufactured homes in RS-GR zoning districts, and the age of newly placed park models in RV and Mobile Home Parks.

Presentation, discussion and direction to staff on whether to terminate the 1992 agreements between the city and the remaining "self-policing" RV parks. In 1992, the city and several parks signed agreements that allowed for the placement of park models, awnings,

screen rooms, storage rooms under 120 square feet, and other similar structures without the need for city permits. Staff is seeking direction whether these agreements should be terminated pursuant to paragraph 11 of said agreements.

M. CALL TO PUBLIC

At this time the public has the privilege to address the council with requests, communications, comments or suggestions relating to city business. All speakers must have already submitted a written "Request to Speak" form to the city clerk no later than the conclusion of the city manager's report portion of the agenda. If there is a group speaking on the same item, they should select a spokesperson. All such remarks shall be addressed to the council as a whole and not to any member thereof. The mayor is authorized to ask a speaker to stop speaking and leave the podium or to adjourn the meeting if anyone becomes disorderly, uncivil, makes personal attacks or continues to speak about items that are not within the jurisdiction of the city after being warned such issues are beyond the jurisdiction of the city to act. The council may not answer questions of the speaker, discuss the matter with one another, but may, at the conclusion: 1) respond to criticism by a speaker; 2) ask the city manager to review a matter; 3) ask the city manager to place the matter on a future agenda. Each speaker must approach the podium, speak into the microphone, provide their name and address. There is a three (3) minute time limit per speaker.
