D. CONSENT AGENDA

The council may, at this time, take single action on any or all items listed as consent agenda items. These may include, but are not limited to, acceptance of agenda, acceptance of minutes, appointments, acceptance of resignations and adoption of certain resolutions and other items which do not require a public hearing. The consent agenda is a timesaving device of which the mayor and city council is to receive documentation on these items from the city manager for their review prior to the meeting. Any member of the council may remove any item from the consent agenda for discussion and cause a separate vote on the matter later in the agenda.

20-612 Consideration of acceptance of agenda. 2. 20-613 Consideration of approval of minutes of the regular meeting of November 17, 2020. 3. 20-621 Consideration of approval of contract to Viasun Corporation for the construction of curbing for select medians on Apache Trail. The work will begin in early 2021 and will be through Pinal County cooperative job order Contract No. 175623 in the amount of \$279,456.32, plus a 10% contingency for unforeseen change orders in the amount of \$27,945.63 for a total project cost not to exceed \$307,401.95. The work will result in curbing to facilitate roadway drainage and protection to the Apache Trail median beautification improvements. 4. 20-548 Consideration of a legal advertising agreement with Arizona Republic for a one year period from January 1, 2021 to December 31, 2021. There is no price increase from the 2020 agreement. 5. 20-633 Consideration for approval of Resolution No. 20-40, a resolution of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Apache Junction, Pinal and Maricopa Counties, Arizona, declaring and adopting the results of the

general election held on November 3, 2020.

H. PUBLIC HEARINGS

Public hearings required by applicable law shall be conducted by the council and any person shall be given the opportunity to speak. All remarks shall be addressed to the council as a whole and not to any member thereof. Such remarks shall be limited to five (5) minutes unless additional time is granted by the mayor. This time limitation shall not apply to applicants and their agents appearing before the council.

Presentation, discussion, public hearing and consideration of proposed Ordinance No. 1499 (case PZ-7-19), a city-initiated rezoning of a 2.37-acres property located at 978 E. Roosevelt Street, from General Rural Low Density Single-family Detached Residential ("RS-GR") to Medium Density Single-family Detached Residential by Planned Development ("RS-20/PD") for the purpose of creating land split and development opportunities.

I. OLD BUSINESS

The council shall consider any business that has been previously considered and which is still unfinished to include those items previously postponed or tabled. No member of the public shall be permitted to speak on these items unless invited to do so by the mayor after first submitting a written request-to-speak form with the city clerk.

This item was continued from the city council meeting of November 17, 2020, wherein council asked for more information about what other cities are doing.

M. CALL TO PUBLIC

At this time the public has the privilege to address the council with requests, communications, comments or suggestions relating to city business. All speakers must have already submitted a written "Request to Speak" form to the city clerk no later than the conclusion of the city manager's report portion of the agenda. If there is a group speaking on the same item, they should select a spokesperson. All such remarks shall be addressed to the council as a whole and not to any member thereof. The mayor is authorized to ask a speaker to stop speaking and leave the podium or to adjourn the meeting if anyone becomes disorderly, uncivil, makes personal attacks or continues to speak about items that are not within the jurisdiction of the city after being warned such issues are beyond the jurisdiction of the city to act. The council may not answer questions of the speaker, discuss the matter with one another, but may, at the conclusion: 1) respond to criticism by a speaker; 2) ask the city manager to review a matter; 3) ask the city manager to place the matter on a future agenda. Each speaker must approach the podium, speak into the microphone, provide their name and address. There is a three (3) minute time limit per speaker.
