## D. CONSENT AGENDA

The council may, at this time, take single action on any or all items listed as consent agenda items. These may include, but are not limited to, acceptance of agenda, acceptance of minutes, appointments, acceptance of resignations and adoption of certain resolutions and other items which do not require a public hearing. The consent agenda is a timesaving device of which the mayor and city council is to receive documentation on these items from the city manager for their review prior to the meeting. Any member of the council may remove any item from the consent agenda for discussion and cause a separate vote on the matter later in the agenda.

- **1.** <u>22-017</u> Consideration of acceptance of agenda.
- 2. <u>22-018</u> Consideration of approval of minutes of the regular meeting of December 7th, 2021.
- 3. 21-734 Consideration of award of contract to Viasun Corporation for the construction of curbing along Apache Trail median between Thunderbird Drive and Gold Drive to facilitate roadway drainage and protection to improvements. The work is scheduled to begin in late January, 2022 and extend into February, 2022 via Pinal County Cooperative Job Order Contract No. 175623 in the amount of \$158,101.46, plus a 10% contingency for unforeseen change orders in the amount of \$15,810.14, for a total project cost not to exceed \$173,911.60.
- 4. 22-027 Consideration of award of bid, HFS21-24, to Lincoln Constructors for lowering and raising manholes, water valves and to survey monuments throughout the city, as needed. Two bids were received. Staff requests award of a one-year contract in an amount not to exceed \$100,000, with auto-renewals up to five years with a total amount not to exceed \$500,000, to Lincoln Constructors for these services.

5. <u>22-032</u> Consideration for approval of Dutchman Dog Park extension of construction agreement with Scholz Contracting LLC to end on June 1, 2022.

#### E. AWARDS, PRESENTATIONS AND PROCLAMATIONS

Awards, presentations from other organizations, proclamations issued by the mayor, and acknowledgement of distinguished guests and visitors, and staff presentation of receipt of grant or donated funds are permitted at this time.

## H. PUBLIC HEARINGS

Public hearings required by applicable law shall be conducted by the council and any person shall be given the opportunity to speak. All remarks shall be addressed to the council as a whole and not to any member thereof. Such remarks shall be limited to five (5) minutes unless additional time is granted by the mayor. This time limitation shall not apply to applicants and their agents appearing before the council.

## I. OLD BUSINESS

The council shall consider any business that has been previously considered and which is still unfinished to include those items previously postponed or tabled. No member of the public shall be permitted to speak on these items unless invited to do so by the mayor after first submitting a written request-to-speak form with the city clerk.

### J. NEW BUSINESS

The council shall consider any business not yet considered. No member of the public shall be permitted to speak on these items unless invited to do so by the mayor after first submitting a written request-to-speak form with the city clerk.

## M. CALL TO PUBLIC

At this time the public has the privilege to address the council with requests, communications, comments or suggestions relating to city business. All speakers must have already submitted a written "Request to Speak" form to the city clerk no later than the conclusion of the city manager's report portion of the agenda. If there is a group speaking on the same item, they should select a spokesperson. All such remarks shall be addressed to the council as a whole and not to any member thereof. The mayor is authorized to ask a speaker to stop speaking and leave the podium or to adjourn the meeting if anyone becomes disorderly, uncivil, makes personal attacks or continues to speak about items that are not within the jurisdiction of the city after being warned such issues are beyond the jurisdiction of the city to act. The council may not answer questions of the speaker, discuss the matter with one another, but may, at the conclusion: 1) respond to criticism by a speaker; 2) ask the city manager to review a matter; 3) ask the city manager to place the matter on a future agenda. Each speaker must approach the podium, speak into the microphone, provide their name and address. There is a three (3) minute time limit per speaker.
