SUBJECT: 2016 HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE EVENT

Each year the city hosts the household hazardous waste event. This event collects hazardous materials, electronic recycling, document shredding, white goods and tires. The city collects over 20,000 pounds of material during a one day event. Pinal County is interested in cost sharing the event this year by inviting residents that reside outside the city limits. This would include those in the unincorporated area just north and east of the city limits as well as Gold Canyon, a map is attached to reference the boundaries.

The city has averaged spending \$23,000 for each event. Pinal County has agreed to pay up to a maximum amount of \$10,000 to cover the costs for county residents to use this event. The city has acquired the vendors needed for the event and will be hosting the event at the Public Works Facility on Saturday, February 20, 2016.

Pinal County will be presenting the Intergovernmental Agreement to the Board of Supervisors on Wednesday, February 3, 2016. Once the Intergovernmental Agreement is executed by Pinal County, staff will seek city council's consideration of entering in to a one-time Intergovernmental Agreement for the upcoming household hazardous waste event at regular session on February 16, 2016.
