Re: Household Hazardous Waste Event

Mayor & City Council-

The city hosts an annual household hazardous waste event each year for city residents to participate in. This year Pinal County approached the city to have county residents in the surrounding area to be included in the event. On February 1, 2016, staff presented the proposed intergovernmental agreement between the city and Pinal County Public Works Department to include Pinal County residents to partake in the city's annual household hazardous waste event.

On February 16, 2016, staff presented proposed Resolution 16-06 allowing the city to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with Pinal County for the household hazardous waste event on Saturday, February 20, 2016. City Council requested that staff give an update of the results from the event. Below shows the total cost of the event, the number of city and county residents that attended the event and the amount of waste collected.

Apache Junction contribution: \$23,000

Pinal County contribution: \$8,757.77

Total Cost for the event: \$31,757.77
