INTERVIEW QUESTIONS AND PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS***

Potential Interview Questions:

1. Why are you interested in serving on the District's Board?
2. Do you live in the City of Apache Junction, and if so are you a customer of the Sewer District?
3. What impressions do you have of the Sewer District?
4. What knowledge do you have of the Sewer District and its operations?
5. The Board of Directors currently meets on the fourth Friday of each month at 8:00 am. Would you be able to commit to regular attendance of these meetings, and additional work sessions or special meetings as necessary?
6. In what other ways are you involved in your community?
7. Are you familiar with wastewater treatment facilities or processes?
8. The District's Board is often asked to approve contracts for goods and/or services with outside vendors and consultants. Have you had prior experience reviewing contracts of this nature?
9. The Board of Directors is asked to evaluate and approve large scale repairs and improvements. The Board is also responsible for reviewing and adopting the District's annual budget, which exceeds \$6.5 million, and for setting the District's annual rates, fees and charges. Would you be comfortable participating in these decisions?
10. How will your past experience help you in this role?

Preferred Qualifications:

- Resident of the City of Apache Junction
- Genuine desire to serve the community
- Reasonable familiarity with the City of Apache Junction
- General knowledge of standard practices in any of the following: construction, engineering, science, accounting, law, public administration or business administration
- Ability to actively engage in discussion and listen to all points of view
- Motivation to present a positive image of the Sewer District to the public
