

ARTICLE 2-1: COUNCIL

§ 2-1-3 DUTIES OF OFFICE.

Council members shall assume the duties of office at the regularly scheduled Council meeting next following the date of the general election at which, or effective as of the date of which, the Council members were elected. There shall no more interruption of a term of office even if Council members are elected outright in the primary election. In such case, new members will not take office until the end of the normal term.

ARTICLE 2-3: COUNCIL ELECTION

§ 2-3-1 PRIMARY ELECTION.

Any candidate who shall receive at the primary election a majority of all the votes cast shall be declared elected to the office for which he or she is a candidate effective as of the date of the swearing in ceremony in June of such election year, and no further election shall be held as to the candidate; provided that if more candidates receive a majority than there are offices to be filled then those equal in number to the offices to be filled receiving the highest number of votes shall be declared elected.
