ARTICLE 2-1: COUNCIL

§ 2-1-3 DUTIES OF OFFICE

Councilmembers shall assume the duties of office once sworn in at the first regular business meeting in January following the general election or at a special meeting in January following the general election or at a special meeting in January following the general election on a date selected by council. at the regularly scheduled council meeting next following the date of the general election at which, or effective as of the date of which, the council members were elected. There shall be no more interruption of a term of office even if councilmembers are elected outright in the preceding August primary election. In such case, new members will not take office until the end of the normal term.

ARTICLE 2-3: COUNCIL ELECTION

§ 2-3-1 PRIMARY ELECTION

Any candidate who shall receives at the majority of the votes cast at the primary election as defined under A.R.S. § 9-821.01, as amended, primary election a majority of the votes cast shall be declared elected to the office for which he or she is a candidate, effective upon completion of as of the date of the swearing-in ceremony held on such date as scheduled pursuant to Apache Junction City Code, Vol. I, Chapter 2: <u>Mayor, Council, and Appointed Boards and Commissions</u>, Article 2-1: <u>Council</u>, § 2-1-3 <u>Duties of Office</u>. in June of such election the following year, and no further election shall be held as to the candidate. provided that if more candidates receive a majority than there are officers to be filled then those equal in number to the offices to be filled receiving the highest number of votes shall be declared elected.
