◆ ABOUT THE ARIZONA INTERFAITH MOVEMENT

The Arizona InterFaith Movement was founded in Phoenix in 1995 when representatives of all the world's great religions in the Valley were invited to meet in friendship and dialogue. A Steering Committee formed and is now the Board of Directors of the nonprofit 501 (c) (3).

Arizona InterFaith Movement's diverse and growing membership includes representatives of the American Indian, Bahá'í, Buddhist, Christian (Catholic, Christian Science, Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints, Community of Christ, Protestant and Tempe Seventh Day Adventist), Falun Dafa, Hare Krishna, Hindu, Humanist, Islam, Jewish, Jain, New Thought (Religious Science, Unity), Sikh, Sufi, Scientology, Unification, Unitarian Universalist and other faith communities in Arizona.

We initiated a Golden Rule campaign which included working with the State Legislature to establish Arizona as the Golden Rule State on May 13, 2003, and an Arizona State Golden Rule license plate in 2007. We organize and / or participate in Community building events that

support putting the Golden Rule into action, emphasizing our common humanity, rather than our doctrinal differences.

The Arizona Interfaith Movement Golden Rule Endowment Fund was established in 2009 with the Arizona Community Foundation. (See their website and GuideStar's website for info.)
