SUBJECT: Presentation/Discussion on bids for Senior Transportation Services

Per Council direction to staff, we released a Request for Proposal ("RFP") Project #PR-17-02 in April for senior transportation services to include daily transportation for those in need to and from the Multi-Generational Center ("MGC"). Even though it is less utilized, we additionally asked for pricing for individual shopping and medical visits. We unfortunately did not receive any bids and so made some minor clarifications and resubmitted a new RFP Project #PR-17-03 in June. Bids were opened on June 20th, 2017 and three bidders submitted proposals. The results are as follows:

Central Arizona Council on Developmental Disabilities ("CACDD") was the apparent low bidder and is a strong non-profit in our community with good experience driving citizens (particularly those with disabilities) to and from programs and work projects.

We will be presenting for discussion our recommendation that a contract be awarded to Central Arizona Council on Developmental Disabilities ("CACDD") in an amount not to exceed \$70,000 (this amount includes a cushion that will allow us to provide more types of trips in the event that additional funding is secured through outside grants and donors). The Term of this Contract shall be from August 28th, 2017 to June 30, 2018 with the ability to automatically renew for four additional one-year (1) periods with the final end date of June 30, 2022.

We will be bringing this item back to you for final approval at your August 1st Council Meeting. Your consideration is greatly appreciated.
