Subject: Roundabout Landscape and Irrigation Maintenance at the Intersection of  
Superstition Boulevard and SR 88  
Proposed Resolution 17-19

The Arizona Department of Transportation ("ADOT") has identified the intersection of Superstition Boulevard and SR 88 within city limits as needing a safety intersection improvement, and will utilize Highway Safety Improvement Program ("HSIP") funds to design and construct the improvements.

There is no cost to the city for design and construction of this project. The ADOT and the city will enter into an agreement for the city to provide landscape and irrigation maintenance in the area of the roundabout. The city will also be responsible for electrical lighting energy costs. The agreement will also allow the city to construct under permit with ADOT visual enhancements to the roundabout.

The Public Works Department is respectfully requesting City Council to approve this Joint Project Agreement (JPA) / Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with ADOT for the landscape and maintenance of the Superstition Boulevard / SR 88 roundabout intersection improvements.
