Mr. Waldron asked what the increase in Central Arizona Project costs is due to. There has been a rapid increase from 2013 to 2017.

District Manager Frank Blanco stated a lot of it has to do with the energy costs, the cost to pump the energy now that they are looking at the Navajo generating station going off line. It was a source for Central Arizona Project electricity. They have projected that will have an impact on their electrical costs. The cost of electricity is pretty significant, the cost of equipment replacement and maintenance is also a big cost. The capital charge has to do with paying back for the actual canal. It was thought that would not increase at that dramatic a rate. He continued with his briefing.

District Superintendent Mike Loggins briefed the board on the proposed rates and changes.

District Director Frank Blanco briefed the board on the proposed classification and compensation plan.

District Director Frank Blanco stated the water district pays for the water and they make sure that the water is available when it is needed. The district is enabled to be able to supply that water to put out the fire by all of those that are connected to the system that are customers paying the monthly base rate. The customers connected to the system will pay for that water.

Vice Chairperson Wilson asked if that is part of the base rate being charged.

District Director Frank

Blanco stated that is correct.

Vice Chairperson Wilson commented they are providing for everyone in the area.

District Director Frank Blanco stated that is correct. That is the monthly base rate.

Vice Chairperson Wilson commented someone asked him about if someone decides they do not

District Director Frank Blanco stated that is correct. It still has to meet the requirements for safe drinking water as well.

District Manager Bryant Powell asked if there are any other reasons the board may need to know as to why it needs to be maintained.

District Director Frank
Blanco stated they have to make sure everything is operating.
They cannot stop treating the water as there are safe drinking
water standards because there are less people out there. They
have to meet all the same requirements they do year round. The
water has to be readily available for health and safety.

Vice Chairperson Wilson commented they cannot lay people off because half the people shut their system down because all the work still needs to be done.

District Director Frank
Blanco stated they still have to check the water to make sure it is safe. They still have to do everything they normally do.

Chairperson Serdy asked if the district donates the water when the fire district fills a tanker.

District Director Frank
Blanco stated they keep track of how much water they use so that
the district can report it on an annual basis to the Department
of Water Resources. We do not charge them for the water.

Chairperson Serdy closed the discussion with no further comments and called for a motion.
