“AMERICAN DIABETES MONTH” NOVEMBER 2017

WHEREAS, in the United States, more than 30 million people – including 682,071 people in Arizona – have diabetes, a serious disease with potentially life-threatening complications including heart disease, stroke, blindness, kidney disease and amputation; and

WHEREAS, an additional 84 million people in the United States are at risk for developing type 2 diabetes; and

WHEREAS, approximately every 21 seconds, someone in the United States is diagnosed with diabetes; and

WHEREAS, an increase in community awareness is necessary to put a stop to the diabetes epidemic.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jeff Serdy, Mayor of the City of Apache Junction, do hereby proclaim November 2017 as
