Subject: Resolution No. 17-32, AJ-Pinal County Street Maintenance IGA

The Public Works Department is requesting City Council approval allowing the mayor to sign the IGA with Pinal County for the exchange of street maintenance for select street segments within or adjoining the corporate boundaries of the city.

Presentation and discussion of this IGA was held with city council on December 5, 2017 and is now being returned as a regular session consent item for approval with accompanying Resolution No. 17-32.

The specific streets identified are either “scaloped” streets, where one jurisdiction owns one half while another jurisdiction owns the other half, or are small segments that are surrounded by the majority of the other jurisdiction. This agreement would specifically add consistency in street maintenance contributing to street quality, street beautification and safety such as through uniform street striping/markings and also add savings to both jurisdictions on maintenance mobilization costs.
