RESOLUTION NO. 17-32

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF APACHE JUNCTION, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF APACHE JUNCTION, ARIZONA, TO ENTER INTO INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH PINAL COUNTY, ARIZONA, DEFINING RESPONSIBILITY FOR ROAD MAINTENANCE OF SUPERSTITION MOUNTAIN DRIVE, SOUTH MOUNTAIN VIEW ROAD AND SOUTHERN AVENUE.

WHEREAS, the City of Apache Junction ("City") and Pinal County ("County") desire to enter into an intergovernmental agreement ("IGA") defining responsibilities of each party for road maintenance of segments of Superstition Mountain Drive, South Mountain View Road and Southern Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the Pinal County Board of Supervisors and Apache Junction City Council both look to limit capital and infrastructure maintenance costs through intergovernmental operation; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to A.R.S. § 11-952(A), public entities may enter into intergovernmental agreements with other municipalities and governmental entities for joint or cooperative activities; and

WHEREAS, the parties have crafted the attached written agreement in the form of an intergovernmental agreement which formalizes the arrangement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF APACHE JUNCTION ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1) The city council hereby mayor and approve the intergovernmental agreement for defining maintenance as set forth in Attachment A; and the mayor is hereby authorized to sign the agreement on behalf of the City.
- 2) The city manager and/or his designee is authorized and directed to take all steps necessary to carry out the purpose and intent of this resolution and to fulfill all the duties required under the IGA.
