Subject: Project #: PW2017-25 Award

City staff respectfully requests city council consideration of award of contract to Viasun Corporation for project PW2017-25. This work budgeted and is included in the FY 2017-18 Street Maintenance Plan. The Plan was discussed at city council work session on April 3, 2017.

The project consists of slurry seal work on portions of Broadway (Meridian Dr. to Idaho Rd.) and Southern (Winchester Rd. to Cortez Rd.) Avenues. Specific work will entail the application of a new wearing surface (slurry seal), applying new striping and raising of surface utilities where applicable. Work would be scheduled during the day only. Majority of the work and related lane closures would less than a week and be during business hours only sometime within the months of March, April or May. It is anticipated temporary closures to adjacent residential and commercial properties will last approximately twenty minutes as maintenance equipment passes and surface is prepared to support vehicular traffic. Public notification is planned to include residential and commercial notifications in the form of fliers along with the usual news and social media releases.
