

## NATIONAL HUMAN TRAFFICKING AWARENESS MONTH JANUARY 2018

- WHEREAS, human trafficking is a form of modern slavery and includes both sex trafficking and labor trafficking; and
- WHEREAS, in 2012 the International Labour Organization of the United Nations estimated that 20.9 million people were victims of human trafficking of which 1,500,000 were in North America; and
- WHEREAS, the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children estimates that 1 in 6 runaway children in the United States reported to the Center in 2016 were victims of sex trafficking; and
- WHEREAS, in 2016 there were 148 cases of human trafficking reported to the National Human Trafficking Resource Center from Arizona; and
- WHEREAS, victims of human trafficking are frequently members of vulnerable populations, such as domestic violence and sexual assault survivors, members of immigrant communities and homeless or runaway youth; and
- WHEREAS, a critical way of reducing human trafficking is to reduce the demand for trafficked services, including commercial sex and labor and all individuals and employers have a responsibility to refrain from engaging in such activities; and
- WHEREAS, the City of Apache Junction seeks to improve our responses, support survivors and promote safe communities for all citizens through services from Community Alliance Against Family Abuse (CAAFA), crisis response from the Apache Junction Police Department and through community awareness efforts.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jeff Serdy, Mayor of the City of Apache Junction, Arizona, do hereby proclaim January 2018 as
