SUBJECT: Lost Dutchman Order of the Eagles #3850, Liquor
Premise Inspection

Captain Mullender,

At your direction I conducted a liquor and business inspection and review of the Arizona Department of Liquor Licenses and Control application dated 12/18/2017 for permanent extension of premises for the Fraternal Order of Eagles #3850 located at 2315 S. Coconino, within the City of Apache Junction. The inspection/review occurred on 12/20/2017.

On 12/20/2017 at approximately 1150 hours we met with the lodge trustee identified by an Arizona Driver's license as Ralph I Stinson (DOB: 1/12/41). Mr. Stinson advised the applicant, Mr. Michael Reed, was not currently available and I conducted a site inspection of the property. Mr. Stinson advised that the business layout and liquor control areas of the establishment of 2315 S. Coconino will remain the same.

I noticed the floor layout matched the layout draft submitted with the application packet. The main entrance to the facility will remain the south doors. The extension along the west side of the building facing the street is a covered patio, approximately 25'X20' enclosed by an approximate 3ft high block wall primarily used for customers who smoke. A gate will later be attached to fully enclose the patio and provide an egress for emergency purposes.

The inspection included locating the nearest schools, daycare and religious facilities. They are as follows:

- There are no designated religious worship facilities or schools within immediate area as defined by liquor enforcement.
- The nearest schools are:
 - Apache Junction High School at 2525 S. Ironwood Drive and,
 - Cactus Canyon Junior High School at 801 W. Southern Avenue.
- These establishments fall outside the 300 foot restriction of ARS 4-207.
- There are no reported liquor violations documented within the Apache Junction Police Department database for this establishment.
- There are no known liquor violations documented with the Arizona Department of Liquor Enforcement.
- Mr. Michael Reed, the applicant, has had no significant contact with the Apache Junction Police Department.

Therefore, with our findings and observations this police department does not object in approving a liquor license for this establishment providing all other statutory requirements per the City of Apache Junction, County of Pinal, and State of Arizona are met.
