PZ-5-17 (Ordinance #1458), a rezoning request by Superstition Mountains Community Facilities District

No. 1 ("SMCFD"), for 5661 S. Ironwood Drive.

Background

SMCFD is requesting a rezoning of three parcels from B-5 (Industrial) and RS-GR (General Rural Low Density Single-Family Detached Residential) to PI/PD (Public and Institutional by Planned Development). The facility is located at 5661 S. Ironwood Drive southeast of S. Ironwood Drive and W. Guadalupe Avenue. The purpose of this rezoning is to uniformly zone the existing SMCFD properties and to expand the wastewater related services including the recharge of treated water through recharge basins, by combining the three parcels, a total of 97.18 acres.

Planning and Zoning Commission Recommendation

On January 9, 2018 the Planning and Zoning Commission held a public hearing regarding this request (P&Z staff report and exhibits attached). The Commission voted to recommend approval of the proposed rezoning request by a vote of 7 to 0. No residents spoke at the public hearing.
