WHEREAS, on July 7, 1998, the City passed and adopted Resolution No. 98-20, which approved the initial CRA Plan; and

WHEREAS, on June 6, 2006, the City passed and adopted Resolution No. 06-23, which approved an updated plan for the CRA; and

WHEREAS, on November 19, 2013, the Resolution No. 13-35, which reaffirmed plan; and
