
City of AJ Event Process

Where is the Event/Activity Location?

- Event is located at a City of AJ park facility: contact Jeff Kopp
- Event is located anywhere else in the City of AJ:
 contact Al Bravo



What type of event is it?

The City Code designates events as being two types:

- Civic Event City partnered events that are primarily sponsored by another local organization adopted by City Council with the annual budget
- Community Event any other event that is sponsored by businesses, non-profits, and private individuals that meet the "Event" definition in the City Code §8-8-2

Additionally, City departments host many different activities/events that fulfill their specific mission/objectives. For the purposes of the code, they follow the guidelines of a "Community Event" when there are vendors/businesses present

Civic Events – 7 Currently Budgeted

- Lost Dutchman Days Rodeo
- Lost Dutchman Days Parade
- Lost Dutchman Marathon
- Arizona Antique Tractor Show
- Ben Johnson Days
- Veterans Day Parade
- Festival of the Superstitions



Community Events - Examples

- Community Appreciation Day Sponsored by businesses; at the AJ News/Lost Dutchman Realty offices parking lot
- Farmers Market Days Sponsored by Horizon Health at Horizon Health & Wellness' EarthHeart Park
- Note: any City department events that have vendors follow the community event process for business activity



Event Considerations

Alcohol served or allowed at the event

- Some of our park facilities allow for an alcohol permit (gives individuals the ability to BRING and CONSUME alcohol at a park facility)
- If events would like to sell or provide alcohol they must go through State Liquor License Board/City Council

Food and Non- Alcoholic Beverages

Perishable/Prepared items are regulated by Pinal County Health Department

Any business activity, promoting, exchanging goods/services for money, etc.

must follow City Code - See CITY OF AJ VENDOR PROCESS information sheet

Other Considerations –

parking/street access, occupancy standards, sanitation standards, tent and food truck inspections by the fire district, liability insurance, etc

Event and Permit Fees



There are fees associated with permits, rental of facilities/equipment, and requests for services.

Fees are kept at a minimal competitive rate, regularly compared with the market, and adopted by City Council

Fees are important to help offset operational and maintenance costs
