






\$10 PURCHASE - SALES TAX DISTRIBUTION

A \$10.00 purchase equates to \$10.96 with taxes included. Of the \$10.96, the city receives \$0.24.




CITY OF APACHE JUNCTION DOES NOT LEVY A PROPERTY TAX


GENERAL FUND REVENUES
