Subject: Resolution 18-29 Pinal County 2018 CWPP

Pinal County Office of Emergency Management ("PCOEM") staff in addition to staff from cities including Apache Junction and fire jurisdictions throughout Pinal County collaborated over the past year to update the Pinal County Community Wildfire Protection Plan ("CWPP"). The resulting 2018 CWPP is an updated version of the 2009 version that was created in response to the Healthy Forests Restoration Act of 2003 and in recognition of the proximity of many communities within Pinal County to landscape-scale fires.

PCOEM gave a short presentation with the opportunity for discussion with city council of this plan on September 4, 2018.

City staff asks City Council to approve and adopt the 2018 CWPP as an official planning document of the City of Apache Junction by resolution. The CWPP is available for review as the attachment to the resolution.
