City Clerk Kathy Connelly explained the canvass of votes officially accepts the primary election results and the deadline for acceptance is today.

City Attorney Joel Stern explained that for city campaign signs the 10-day period would begin on September 18th and unless the signs were in a right-of way staff should not automatically remove any city election signs at the end of this period but instead should contact

the candidate to remove the signs themselves.

Ms. Connelly explained that the seating of the elected council members takes place at the first regular council meeting in January which is scheduled for January 15, 2019.
