Subject: Implementation update on the Pinal County Multi-Jurisdictional
Hazard Mitigation Plan

In 2017 through Resolution 17-26 the City of Apache Junction gave concurrence/adoption of the revised Pinal County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan ("MJHMP"). Adoption of the MJHMP and its maintenance actions are required by the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 and Federal Emergency Management Administration. This keeps the City of Apache Junction eligible for certain categories of federal disaster monies.

As part of the MJHMP's maintenance, an update by city staff of its implementation elements will be presented to the mayor and city council.
