□§ 2-1-3 DUTIES OF OFFICE.

Council members shall assume the duties of office at the regularly scheduled Council meeting next following the date of the general election at which, or effective as of the date of which, the Council members were elected. There shall no more interruption of a term of office even if Council members are elected outright in the primary election. In such case, new members will not take office until the end of the normal term.

D§ 2-1-4 VACANCIES IN COUNCIL.

The Council shall fill by appointment for the unexpired term any vacancy that may occur for whatever reason, but such appointee shall only fill the remainder of the term.

- (A) The salary for the position of Mayor shall be paid at the rate of \$1,000 per month.
- (B) The salary for the position of Vice Mayor shall be paid at the rate of \$900 per month.

Prior to taking office, every Council member shall execute and file an official bond, enforceable against the principal and his or her sureties, conditioned on the due and faithful performance of his or her official duties, payable to the state and to and for the use and benefit of the city or any person who may be injured or aggrieved by the
