Munster and Mokena were established communities where a lot of the activity was "fine tuning", but we still had significant issues like cell towers, billboards, and commercial / residential interfaces. The key to Planning is having a long term view of where the community is directed. For a developing community like Apache Junction, the long term is even more important, so the Planning group needs to have clear direction and understanding with the City Council. There is also an interesting proactive / reactive nature to the task because development only occurs when someone brings an idea to us - the city is not making the investment but needs to make sure that the investments being made are in the best interests of the long term development of the community.
