Subject: Utilization of Unobligated Surface Transportation Program (STP) Funds  
Southern Avenue Roadway Improvement Project

Although the timing is extremely aggressive, the City has pursued and is hoping to utilize these available funds on Southern Avenue from Ironwood Drive to Delaware Drive as follows:

Per the original IGA dated May 14, 2015, the City is in an agreement with ADOT for the following:

Federal-aid Funds:	\$ 1,471,697.00
<b>City's Match:</b>	<u>\$ 88,957.00</u>
<b>Subtotal – Construction</b>	<b>\$ 1,560,654.00</b>

Amendment No. 1 of the IGA will have the following cost break down:

<b>Total Estimated City Match</b>	<u><b>\$ 204,570.00</b></u>
<b>Total Estimated Construction</b>	<b>\$ 2,362,460.00</b>

The Public Works Department is requesting City Council approval to enter into Amendment No. One to the Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with ADOT which will provide additional funding for the construction of the Southern Avenue Roadway Improvement Project.
