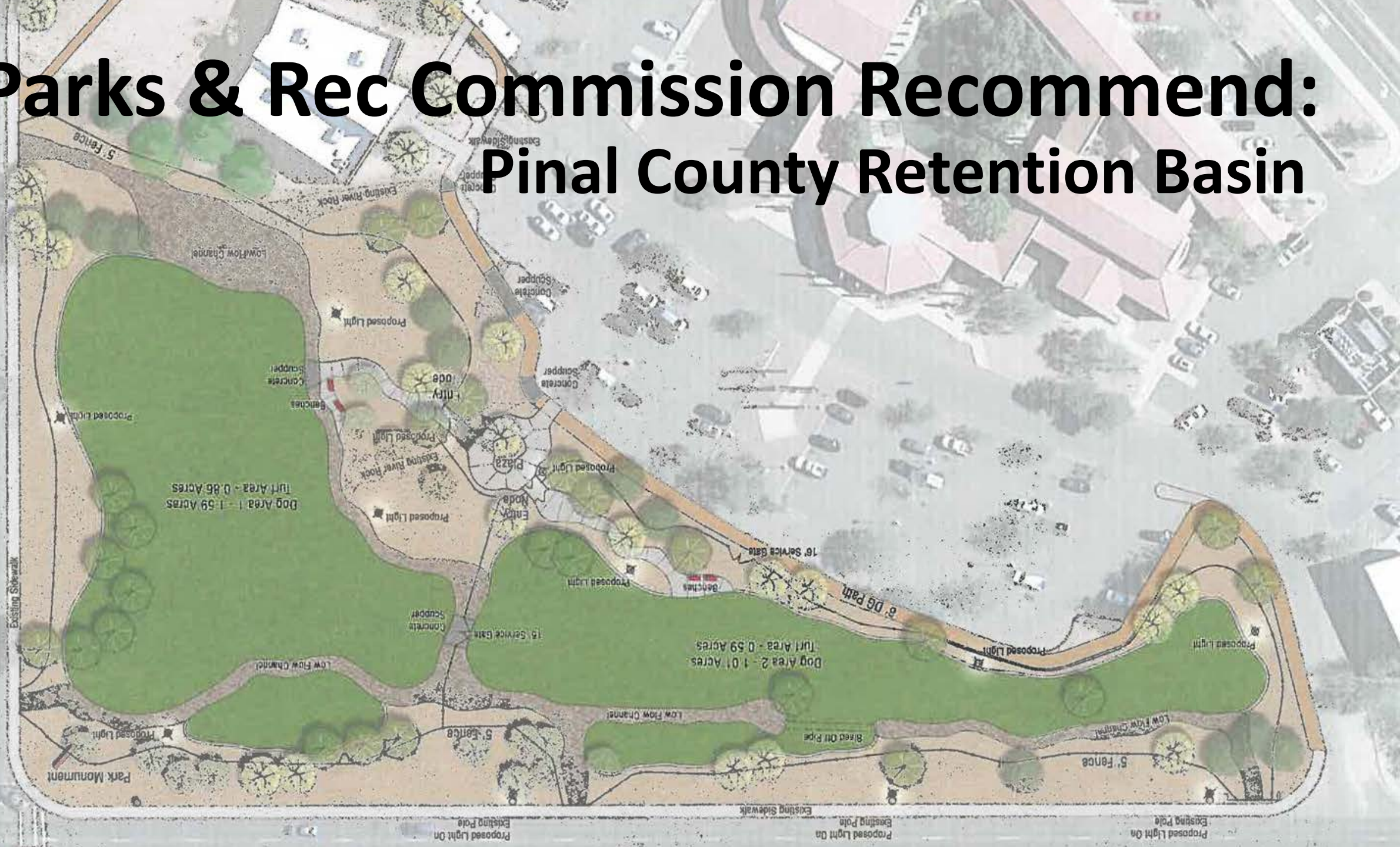

\$3.5 million 4.3 acres (4 sections)	\$4 million 4.4 acres (3 sections)	\$650 thousand 2.6 acres (2 sections)
City lease on BLM	City lease on BLM	County patent on BLM
Adjacent to existing infrastructure	No existing infrastructure	Has existing infrastructure
Some existing mature shade trees	Requires adding shade	Lots of existing mature shade trees
Adjacent to a developed park	Isolated, but provides a secluded area for users	In the downtown core, proximity to residents
