The public works department budgeted \$185,000 for a gannon tractor and Freightliner to be used as a new water truck using highway user revenue funds (HURF) in the city's Fiscal Year 2019/2020 budget approved by city council in June. Staff respectively requests these items for the purchase in an amount not to exceed \$185,000 be placed on the consent agenda for the July 16, 2019 city council meeting as done in prior years. The 2019 Case 570NEP Gannon Tractor with a fully enclosed cab 4 in 1 bucket, gannon box and power take off is a replacement for a 2007 Case 570MXT Gannon Tractor Unit 30-249 with approximately 6,200 hours and in fair condition. The 2019 Freightliner M2-60 cab and chassis is a replacement for a 2000 Freightliner FL80 Unit 30-209 with approximately 107,500 miles, cracked engine block and in poor condition.

The purchase of the gannon tractor would be through the cooperative Minnesota State Contract #140725 in the amount of \$91,500. The purchase of the Freightliner would be through the cooperative Houston-Galveston Area Council Contract #HT06-018 in the amount of \$93,500, installation of the water tank from Unit 30-209, add 750 gpm water pump, plumb, add spray heads and any emergency lighting.



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
