# Technical Proposal

- Technical Proposal worth 200 points consisted of scoring on:
  - General Experience
  - Experience and Qualifications
  - Method of Approach
  - Public Education and Outreach
  - Billing and Customer Service
  - Clarity, thoroughness of proposal
  - Recognition of addenda/addendum
- 5 City staff members' average scores on the Technical Proposal
  - Allied Waste Transportation, Inc. dba Republic Services 194.8
  - Waste Management of Arizona, Inc. 172.6
  - Right Away Disposal 155.6

# Alternative Services

Alternative Services	Curbside Solid Waste pick-up only (2 times a week)– NO Recycling	Curbside Solid Waste pick-up (2 times a week) PLUS Recycling (once a week)
Allied Waste Transportation, Inc dba Republic Services	\$10.71	\$18.71
Waste Management of Arizona, Inc	\$23.37	No bid
Right Away Disposal	\$14.50	\$20.81



# Conclusion

Staff recommends the city enter into contract negotiations with Allied Waste Transportation, Inc. dba Republic Services.

Staff seeks council direction to staff on whether to include the standard service or the alternate bid in the contract negotiations.
