SUBJECT:	Updates to AM 1-19 - Presentation and Discussion on Public Art Ordinances

## BACKGROUND

This item was on the July 2<sup>nd</sup> agenda for a brief introduction and on the July 23<sup>rd</sup> agenda for a more in-depth review. At the July 23<sup>rd</sup> meeting, Commissioners asked for copies of art in private development ordinances from other cities. Staff researched other communities and found that Chandler, Surprise, Glendale, Oro Valley, Tempe, Peoria, Sedona, Scottsdale, and Phoenix have arts ordinances. Mesa does not currently have an arts ordinance. A spreadsheet is attached that outlines what other Arizona cities are doing with public art as part of the building permit process and for municipal capital improvement projects along with a link to their ordinance if available. Also, commissioners had opinions on the qualifications to be considered an "artist." Staff continues to recommend the language that was provided to the city by its consultant Dianne Cripe of Artspace6.

This item is scheduled for a Public Hearing on August 27<sup>th</sup> at the Planning and Zoning Commission and will be presented to the city Council on September 3<sup>rd</sup> and again on September 17<sup>th</sup> for a Public Hearing and final adoption. The council hopes to appoint commission members in October.
