Subject: Extinguishment of Federal Patent Easements
Forest Street (Alignment) from Tomahawk Road to Vista Road
Rescind Recorded Resolution No. 19-15

Resolution 19-15 was adopted by city council July 16, 2019. The purpose of the resolution was to extinguish federal patent easements for the Forest Street (Alignment) from Tomahawk Road to Vista Road, had never been opened for public use or maintained by the City.

It's brought to staff's attention that Exhibit "A" of the resolution described the Smoketree Street easement below instead of the Forest Street alignment. Exhibit "B" is shown correctly. Public Works would like to re-record Resolution 19-15 correcting Exhibit "A" as it should pertain to Forest Street and not Smoketree.
